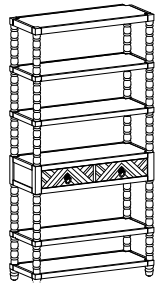

- ☒ When in use, do not exceed the maximum load of 30lbs

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE:

- ☒ Acacia wood is a hard and fibrous wood.
- ☒ Avoid placing furniture in direct sunlight. Ultraviolet rays can damage wood finishes.
- ☒ Dust often using a clean, soft, dry and lint-free cloth.
- ☒ We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives on our product.

MADE4HOME

- ☑ If it is cracking and chipping occur, recommend we proceed as follows:
 - Abrade the affected areas / areas in a controlled manner with sandpaper.
 - Paint the sanded areas with the paint suitable use.
- ☑ Use coasters or pot holder to help prevent marks or stains. Do not place hot items directly on the surface. Wipe the table clean with a soft, dry cloth after each use. The occasional application of a high-quality clear furniture wax will help protect the finish from minor stains.
- ☑ DRAWERS: If the drawer doesn't slide as easily as it should, simply rub a candle on the drawer glides (the bottom of drawer where wood contacts wood). The wax coating will ensure smooth operation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- ☑ Install on an even floor. Do not stand/sit on the product. Do not use sharp units or pressure washer on product's surface
- ☑ Always keep the product away from heat source such as outdoor grill, flame, cigarette,...
- ☑ Active use may loosen bolts and screws to become loose. Perform a hardware check every few months or so.
- ☑ To maintain the color of the wood, you should avoid direct sunlight as far as possible.
- ☑ Please never store wooden furniture in warm, dry rooms such as Boiler rooms. This can cause hairline cracks to form favor
- ☑ Anti tip kits must be applied to avoid flipping over
