Installation Steps

Turn off the power at fuse or circuit box.

- 1. Attach mounting plate unit (A) to outlet box using two mounting screws (B).
- 2. Rod Connections:
 - a. Thread the fixture wire from the fixture through the lower rod, and then secure the lower rod onto fixture using the threaded pipe.
 - b. Thread the fixture wire through the middle rod, and then secure the middle rod onto the lower rod using the threaded pipe.
 - c. Thread the fixture wire through the upper rod, and then secure the upper rod onto the middle rod using the threaded pipe.

Note: Length adjustable from 17" to 66". Use fewer rods if shorter length is desired.

- Thread the fixture wire through canopy, and then secure the rod assembly to the set threaded pipe.
- 4. Carefully adjust the 8 pcs long rods as the picture shown by rotating the long rods slightly in the same direction.
- 5. Pull out the source wires from the outlet box. Make wire connections using wire connectors (C) as follows: ---Connect the smooth-coated wire (marked) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - ----Connect the ribbed-coated wire (unmarked) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source. ---Attach the fixture ground wire to the mounting plate unit (A) with the green ground screw, then connect it to
 - the house ground wire with a wire connector (C). Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.
- 6. Install 8 X 60W Max. medium base bulbs (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.





- 7. Attach the canopy to the mounting plate unit (A), and then secure it with two bolt nuts (D).
- 8. Angled mounting recommended for a vaulted or angled ceiling. (See Fig. 1)
- 9. This fixture also can be used as a semi-flush mount when use shorter rod and keep the rods flat.

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit box.
