
TOOLS AND MATERIALS



Adjustable Wrench



9 mm Hex Wrench




Strap Wrench




Thread Sealant



Plumbers Putty



- ☐ Install a male 1/2" NPT pipe to extend 1/2" (13 mm) beyond the finished wall.
- ☐ Apply thread sealant tape to the exposed threads of the pipe nipple.
- ☐ Apply a bead of plumbers putty or other sealant to the back of the shower arm according to the putty manufacturer's instructions.
- ☐ Thread the shower arm onto the pipe nipple.
- ☐ Use a clean strap wrench to securely tighten the shower arm.
- Turn on the water supply.
- ☐ Run hot and cold water through the shower arm to flush out dirt and debris.
- ☐ Check for leaks. Repair as necessary.
- □ Remove any excess plumbers putty.
- ☐ Unthread the shower arm adapter from the shower arm using a 9 mm hex wrench.



- ☐ Apply thread sealant to the shower arm adapter.
- ☐ Thread the adapter tightly into the showerhead while securing the ball joint with a clean adjustable wrench. Be careful not to scratch the finish with the wrench.
- ☐ Thread the showerhead tightly into the shower arm.
- ☐ Check for proper operation.
