The step-by-step guidelines in the installation instructions are a general reference for installing a Swiss Madison Sink. Should there be any discrepancies, Swiss Madison cannot be held liable. It is recommended to install all Swiss Madison products by hiring a licensed professional

- 1. Read the complete instruction manual before beginning installation.
- 2. Confirm that your model will fit in intended location and plumbing fixtures are located where legally required before beginning installation.
- 3. These installation instructions are for solid surface, composite material countertops.
- 4. Not all drawings on this manual are drawn to scale. Please refer to the model chart.
- 5. Two people are recommended to install and move this product.

1. Determine Reveal Type





Positive: Sink rim is exposed approximately 1/4" from edge of countertop (Figure B)



Flush: Sink edge is flush with countertop opening (Figure C)

NOTE: This manual instructs specifically for mounting a FLUSH reveal type. Make sure to consult your plumber about desired reveal type PRIOR to installation.

2. Clean Countertop

• Make sure to thoroughly clean the underside of the countertop and let it dry completely.

Note: The undersides of counters tend to be rough and unfinished which makes it easy to hold debris. You want to make sure it's clean so nothing interferes with the bond between adhesive and the countertop.



3. Position and Trace Sink

- Flip sink upside down on top countertop in the desired location you want the sink to be.
- Trace the outline of the sink onto the countertop.

Note: Make sure clearance is suitable for back splash, faucet, and plumbing for the sink.



4. Cut Countertop

• Cut an opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line.

Notes:

- Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.
- Professional should be consulted for cutting countertop



5. Secure Sink to Countertop

- Once again clean underside of the countertop and around cut-out area making sure area is free of defects.
- Apply a liquid nail or adhesive of choice to the rim of the sink near the inside edge. Be careful not to miss or skip any area.
- Carefully lift sink squarely under countertop cut-out. Press firmly on sink to form seal and seal sink. Immediately wipe excess sealant with damp cloth. Be careful not to smear or spread sealant onto countertop or sink.



6. Installing Plumbing Fixtures

- Turn counter back over.
- Connect drain, trap to drain, and water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instruction.
- Test run water into sink and check for leaks.
