Do I need to seal my porcelain/ceramic sink?

All sealers will break down over time and become less effective. And the glaze on your porcelain sink is no different. Most ceramic sinks, to a degree, loose their luster and therefore it is important to protect your sink against harmful substances in every day use. Your ceramic sink will come with Glacier Ice which should be applied. We then recommend re-sealing with Glacier Ice every year or two. If your porcelain sink is properly sealed, it will pretty much last for hundreds of years!

Should I hire or consult a professional?

One average sized porcelain sink can weigh around 62 lbs! Then fill it with water and dishes... So, your sink may require custom cabinetry, as well as additional reinforcement in order to guarantee proper fit and safety. We highly recommend hiring an experienced cabinet maker for help.

Each sink will vary slightly in size because of the manufacturing process. Therefore, we suggest that you provide your cabinet maker with the actual sink to ensure a custom and safe fit. Otherwise, a poorly reinforced cabinet may lead to accidents, personal injury, or destruction of your sink.

FAQs

Considering porcelain sinks are manufactured, are there any differences I should know about between them and other materials?

About the only problem with porcelain is that it can crack or chip, which typically happens if you drop something such as a heavy pot into your sink. It can also become stained which means food or liquids that are poured into the sink or food or liquids which aren't quickly wiped away can cause discoloration over time. But porcelain is a durable material, so with reasonable care, you can enjoy all the benefits this kind of sink offers.
