

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Description: Porter Console Table

Important safety instructions:

- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the table.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.

Pre-assembly:

- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach each post (P2) to the bottom of top frame (P1). **Note**: Make sure short section on the top of short post(P2) is attached to the bottom of top frame (P1) as shown below. Securely tighten the posts (P2).





Step 4.

1) Turn the assembled table to an upright position.

2) **Recommend that you attach the products to your wall as a safety precaution.** Please see the other instructions **"Furniture Safety Bracket Tip Resistant"**.

3) Place the clear plastic pad (H1) on the top frame (P1) and shelf frame (P3) as shown below.

4) Gently lay the top glass (P7) and shelf glass (P8) on the top frame (P1) and shelf frame (P3) as shown below. Assembly is complete.

Furniture Safety Bracket Tip Resistant

- Designed to help prevent furniture tipover.
- Detachable strap allows for easy moving of furniture for cleaning.
- Also helps prevent furniture from tipping during minor tremors.

Installation:

Bolt (1pc)

Long Screw (1pc) ⊲‱‱∭

Strap (1pc)



Bracket (2pcs)



1. Locate a wall stud behind your furniture. Position a bracket on the stud approximately 1" below the top frame of the furniture. Mark and drill pilot hole into the center of the stud with a 3/32" drill bit. Attach a bracket to the stud with the long screws provided. Making sure the metal bracket extend UPWARD as shown.

2. On the back of the furniture. Attach the metal bracket to the back of top frame with bolt, making sure the metal bracket extend DOWNWARD as shown.

3. Move the furniture into its final position, taking care to line up the wall bracket with the furniture bracket. Thread a strap through the bracket as shown in the illustration. Tighten strap until snug. Do not over tighten.

Important:

Check to be sure the wall bracket is firmly screwed into wall stud, the furniture bracket is firmly attached to the frame, and the strap is snug.
