- When installing your new faucet, first hand tighten the water supply hoses then use a wrench to give the compression nuts an additional (1/4) turn. Do not overtighten the compression nuts as it will reduce the integrity of the sealed connection.

Maintenance Guide

Please follow the cleaning material manufacturer's instructions. Damage caused by improper treatment will not be covered by product warranty. In addition, pay attention to the following points:

- Regular cleaning can prevent mineral build up on faucet spout.
- Carefully read the cleaner product label to ensure the cleaner is safe for use on the material.
- Test the cleaner on a small area before using on the entire surface.
- Use a mild detergent such as liquid dishwashing soap and warm water for cleaning.
- Do not use abrasive / harsh chemical when cleaning the fixture as they will damage and dull the finish.
- When using spray cleaners, spray first onto a soft cloth or sponge. Never spray directly onto the faucet as droplets can enter openings and gaps and cause damage.
- After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove any cleaner residue.

Installation

IMPORTANT:

- This product should be installed by professional installers.
- It is strongly recommended to dry fit all parts before final installation.
- Install shut off valves for the water supply to roman tub faucet at an easily accessible location.
- Provide adequate clearance around the roman tub faucet for easy installation and maintenance.



1. The Diverter Tee Connector and Mounting Hardware must be removed from the Tub Spout before installation. (CAUTION: DO NOT damage the rubber gasket and the spring on the Diverter Rod)



2. Place tub spout through the mounting hole and thread on the mounting kit. Tighten the 2 screws with a screwdriver to secure the tub spout in place.



3. Install the Diverter T Connector and the Coupling back onto the tub spout and attach the Connecting Hose as shown.



4. Insert the Control Handle through the deck and secure the unit with C Shape Rubber Washer, C Shape Metal Washer and Locking Nut. Attach the other end of the Connecting Hose to this Control Handle.



5. Remove the Rubber Washer and Locking Nut from the Hand Shower Base. Insert the base through the deck hole and secure it with the washer and the locking nut.



6. Attache Hand Shower Hose to the Hand Shower as shown. Insert the other end of the hose into the Hand Shower Base.

Installation



7. Connect the Hand Shower Hose to the Hand Shower Connecting Hose. Connect both Water Supply Hoses to the shut off valves.



8. Turn on both shut off valves. Lift the handle to turn on water flow. Check all connections for leaks.



9. Remove the Aerator with an adjustable wrench. Turn of the tub filler to flush water lines thoroughly. Lift the Hand Shower from its base. Divert the water to Hand Shower by lifting up the Diverter Lever. Check for leaks at the Hand Shower connections.

Operations



1. To operate the Tub Filler simply lift up the handle to the ON position to turn on the water. Adjust the temperature by moving the handle from side to side to set the desired water temperature.

2. To operate the Handshower Wand, remove the Handshower from its base and direct the jets into the tub. Move the Diverter Lever up to divert water to the Hand Shower. Return the Diverter Lever to its original position to divert the water back to the Tub Spout.
