

COTTON

Clean spills immediately. Blot liquids with a dry absorbent white cloth or white paper towel. Regular vacuuming and the occasional gentle shake should keep your rug in shipshape condition. Please do not machine wash, bleach or tumble dry. Professional rug cleaning recommended.

COW HIDE

To keep your cowhide looking fresh and feeling soft, occasionally brush your hide with a hard plastic brush. In case of spills, spot treat using a damp cloth with a mild detergent, wiping the hide in the direction of the hairs. DO NOT wash in a washing machine or dry clean.

NATURAL FIBERS

Visible and loose dirt should be regularly picked up with a broom or vacuum cleaner. Liquid spills can dissolve dirt particles and bring them to the surface causing watermarks to form. Therefore spills must be dabbed immediately with an absorbent white cloth and then dried.

SILK

Clean spills immediately. Blot liquids with a dry absorbent white cloth or white paper towel. Regular vacuuming should keep your rug in shipshape condition. Please do not machine wash, bleach or tumble dry. Professional rug cleaning recommended.

SYNTHETIC

Regular vacuuming helps rugs retain their beauty and extends the life of the rug. Clean spills immediately: blot clean with a clean cloth and a solution of clear dishwashing detergent (non-bleach) and water. Do not dry clean. Do not bleach. Professional rug cleaning recommended.

100% WOOL

Vacuum regularly as new wool rugs can shed yarn fibers for up to three months. Avoid direct and continuous exposure to sunlight. Do not pull loose ends, clip them with scissors to remove. Clean liquid spills immediately by blotting with cloth or sponge. For hard to remove stains, professional rug cleaning is recommended.
