Instruction Manual



IMPORTANT INFORMATION MUST READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING PRODUCT

- Follow the in formation on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
- Use only a mattress which is 74-75" L x 37.5-38.5"W x 9"H on the upper and lower bunk.
- Replacement Parts—Replacement parts, including additional guardrails, may be obtained from any of Walker Edison Furniture's dealers or by contacting Walker Edison Furniture online at <u>www.walkeredison.com</u>.
- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. DO NOT remove warning label from bed.
- Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in . (127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails. Mattress must not exceed a maximum thickness of 9 inches.
- DO NOT allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- DO NOT allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- DO NOT use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
- Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk . If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.
- The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
- STRANGULATION HAZARD Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts and jump ropes.
- Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.

Attach ladder frame assembly to the upper cross bar on the right side using screw (1) and washer (2) on the left side using screw (3) and washer (4) as shown in the illustration.

Attach ladder support posts to the lower cross bar using screws (4) and washers (3) as shown in the illustration

Attach open guardrail (K) to the upper cross bar using screws (4) and washers (3), then attach upper guardrail (K) to the support post using screw (1) and washer (2) as diagram shown. Be sure to tighten all screws firmly.

Note the ladder and open guardrail on the left side.







Attach ladder frame assembly to the upper cross bar on the right side using screw (1) and washer (2) on the left side using screw (3) and washer (4) as shown in the illustration.

Attach ladder support posts to the lower cross bar using screws (4) and washers (3) as shown in the illustration

Attach open guardrail (K) to the upper cross bar using screws (4) and washers (3), then attach upper guardrail (K) to the support post using screw (1) and washer (2) as diagram shown. Be sure to tighten all screws firmly.

Note the ladder and open guardrail on the right side.
