

Here are some pointers for taking care of your new copper wind spinner:

These sculptures are made out of solid copper. The colors you see are created with heat. Think of it as painting with a torch. These colors will fade in time and the copper will go thru its own natural patina process. First it will become browner and eventually develop a blue green patina like you see on old copper roofs and statues.

If you want to preserve the copper, you can spray the sculpture with any clear finish [polyurethane, acrylic, or lacquer] that prevents it from oxidizing and going through the natural patina process. Use a soft cloth or cotton gloves throughout this process.

**Please be careful when handling these handmade wind spinners as sometimes the edges can be sharp as they are hand-crafted and welded.

**You will also see some weld marks on these spinners, this is perfectly normal as they are made by hand.
