WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION OF THIS LIGHTING FIXTURE BE DONE BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

WARNING *** SWITCH OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER BEFORE INSTALLATION.

INSPECT ITEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO INSTALL. IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE OR OBVIOUS DEFECT, DO NOT INSTALL.

ITEM MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE IT HAS BEEN INSTALLED.

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the carton. Screw finial onto bottom nipple of fixture body.
- 2. Attach chain to top loop on chandelier and close link. Feed wire through chain and mounting loop.
- 3. Unscrew canopy ring and slide canopy on chain.
- 4. Attach mounting strap to mounting outlet box using mounting screws provided.
- 5. Insert thread nipple in mounting strap.
- 6. Attach chain mounting loop to thread nipple using screws provided.
- 7. Attach chain with fixture to chain mounting loop at desired height.
- 8. Attach the ground wire (silver or brass in color) from the fixture to the ground junction box wire (usually green or copper wire).
- 9. Fasten together with a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Be sure no wire strands are exposed.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.

- Connect the neutral wire from the fixture (ridges molded wire) to the neutral wire from the junction box (usually white). Fasten together with a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Be sure no wire strands are exposed.
- 11. Connect the hot wire from the fixture (smooth wire) to the hot wire (usually black) from the junction box. Fasten each a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Be sure that no wire strands are exposed. DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OR SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.
- 12. Tuck wire connections neatly into ceiling outlet box.
- 13. Slip canopy to ceiling and secure with threaded canopy ring.
- 14. Insert light bulbs into the sockets. Clip the shades on each light bulbs
