

Bathroom Sink Installation Instructions

General Information on Installation

- 1) SimplyCopper recommends using a licensed plumber to install our copper sinks and drains.
- 2) All SimplyCopper sinks are handmade by Mexican Artisans; therefore, the dimensions may vary slightly from sink to sink. You will use the sink as your template for the cutout.
- 3) For sealing, you will use clear 100% non-water-based silicone that can be purchased at your local hardware store.
- 4) Observe and comply with all building and plumbing codes.

Surface Mount

- 1) You will use the sink as your template. Place the sink upside down on the countertop and mark the countertop by tracing the edge of the sink. Make allowances for the faucet and any accessories.
- 2) Measure inside edge of sink lip and mark countertop accordingly.
- 3) Cut countertop midway between the two lines
- 4) Temporarily place sink in cut out to verify proper fit.
- 5) Apply 100% non-water-based silicone around the cut out in countertop and place the sink in cut out.
- 6) Wipe any excess silicone off the countertop using a clean dry cloth.

Under Mount

- 1) You will use the sink as your template. Place the sink upside down on the countertop and mark the countertop by tracing the edge of the sink. Make allowances for the faucet and any accessories.
- 2) Measure inside edge of the lip and mark countertop accordingly. This is your inside line.
- 3) Cut the countertop on the inside line.
- 4) Place the sink to verify fit.
- 5) Apply 100% non-water=based silicon around the underside of the hole and position the sink.
- 6) Mounting clip fasteners may be used to secure the under mount sink.
- 7) Wipe any excess silicone off the countertop using a clean dry cloth.
