
- Do not discard any content until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.





Assembly Procedures:


Step 1. Assemble the stool on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Insert legs (P2, P3) with dowel to the legs (P4, P5) according to the labels "P2", "P3", "P4", "P5" each leg (P2, P3, P4, P5) as shown below.



Step 2. Take the swivel out from the box, then turn the swivel to the position as shown below. **Loosely** attach the swivel (H6) to the top of assembled legs using short bolts (H1), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4) as shown below.




Step 3. Loosely attach metal stretcher (P6) to each leg using long bolts (H2) as shown below. Turn the assembled base to an upright position, make sure the base is level and securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H5).



Step 4.

- 1) **Loosely** attach the assembled base to chair top (P1) as shown below, using short bolts (H1), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4). Securely tighten the bolts with Allen wrench (H5).
- 2) Turn the assembled stool to an upright position. Assembly is complete. Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY:

BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE.

THEY SHOULD BE INSPECTED AT LEAST EVERY 3 MONTHS AND RE-TIGHTENED AS NEEDED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY, AND ENSURE STABILITY.
