

Always have at least two people to help transport and assemble the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.




CAM LOCK FASTENER


Every cam bolt must have a cam lock connector to hold the parts together.


When assembling, the hardware parts and the wooden board must be kept vertical, and the tools must be in full contact with the hardware groove.






Caution:

Do not use excessive force to advoid over-fastening, or even exceed the entire board.





Slowly rotate the cam lock clockwise until it stops rotating.






When assembling the cam lock, do not use an electric screwdriver to avoid damage to the board or hardware due to excessive force.

DOWEL



ATTENTION

Inserting wood dowels is likely to be tight, so wood dowels may not easily touch the bottom and damage the side panels during installation. It is recommended to slight hit the wooden pins with a hammer to eliminate the gap between the wood dowel and board.




OPTIONAL

It is recommended to use white glue to increase the safety of the produst. If you are worried about assembly errors, you can temporarily not add it, and then add it after confirming.







Attention






Extend the two outer slides of the runners so that they could align with the sides of the drawer. Make sure the pre-drilled holes from the drawer align with the screw holes of the outer slides.



Secure two screws from the inside of the drawer using a Phillips screwdriver to tighten them to the outer slides.



ASSEMBLY IS COMPLETED.

Make sure the product is rested on a flat surface and does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts/screws are secured and properly tightened.
