





# READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO ASSEMBLE THIS BED.

#### F1427-13 SAFETY WARNINGS AND GENERAL NOTES:

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk bed end structure and on the carton. Do not remove the warning label from the bed.
- Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls. (See Page 26)
- The top surface of the mattress must be at least 5" below the upper edge of the guardrails. (See Page 26)
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- Periodically check and ensure the guardrail, ladder and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and all connectors are tight.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed. Always prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Use of a night-light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
- Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk.
- If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
- The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.
- We recommend assembling your bunk bed on the shipping carton to protect your floor or carpet. Be certain all staples are out of the box before beginning assembly on the shipping carton.

**STRANGULATION HAZARD** - Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jumpropes.






- The assembly will require at least two people to complete.
- Make sure all the fasteners are tight.
- Due to the size of this bed, It must be assembled within the space it will occupy
- Above all, take your time and read the instruction carefully.



Do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting bolts/screws as this could damage the unit.










Attach and secure **Divider** onto **Top & Bottom Shelf** and insert **(D)** and **(F)** to tighten it up by using **(U)**.






Attach Top Shelf and Bottom Shelf onto Guardrail Rear and insert (D) and (F) tighten it up by using (U).













 $^{*}$  Align both **Guardrail (Front/Rear)** and **Side Rail (Front/Rear)** before tightening the screws.


























Attach **Drawer Base Support** onto **Drawer Rear** by using **(P),(H)** and **(J)**, tighten it up by using







## **MATTRESS SIZE**

**Upper Bunk Mattress Specification:** 

- Only use a mattress that is 75" 76" long and 37 1/2" 38 1/2" wide on upper bunk.
- Ensure thickness of mattress does not exceed 9".

Lower Bunk Mattress Specification:

- Only use a mattress that is 76" long and 54" wide on lower bunk.
- Ensure thickness of mattress is 11" only.

#### Replacement parts:

Replacement parts, including additional guard rails, can be obtained from any ACME distributor or retailer.
