Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the chair on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Remove the fixed plate from the bottom of chair back top (P1) by unscrewing out of the screws with screw driver(not provided).







Step 6.

- 1) Turn the assembled chair to an upright position. Make sure the chair is level and securely tighten all bolts by Allen wrench (H9, H10).
- 2) Assembly is complete. Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE INSPECTED AT LEAST EVERY 3 MONTHS AND RE-TIGHTENED AS NEEDED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY, AND ENSURE STABILITY. Thank you for your purchase

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
