

Assembly Procedures:


Step 1, Assemble the counter stool on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach the seat (P2) to the chair back (P1) as shown below. Loosely tighten with Allen wrench (H6).

(H4)x1 Large Lock Washers 5/16"


Step 2. Attach the rear corners of the seat (P2) to the chair back (P1) as shown below. Loosely tighten with Allen wrench (H6).

(H4)x4 Large Lock Washers 5/16"





Step 3. Insert the left stretcher (P3) to the chair back (P1), then loosely attach the left assembled arm and leg (P6) to the rear corners of seat (P2) and left stretcher (P3) as shown below. Do not tighten the bolts at this time.




- Step 4.
- 1) Repeat step 3 to assemble the right stretcher (P4) and right assembled arm and leg (P7) as shown below. Do not tighten the bolts at this time.
- 2) Insert the front stretcher (P5) to the left assembled arm and leg (P6) and right assembled arm and leg (P7). Securely tighten all bolts.
- 3) Tighten all screws (H7) through the stretchers (P3, P4, P5) to the front legs and chair back legs.


Step 5.

- 1) Attach the left assembled arm and leg (P6) and right assembled arm and leg (P7) to the chair back (P1) as shown below. Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench(H11).
- 2) Insert wood plugs (H12) to cover each exposed bolt hole. **Note:** if needed, use a rubber mallet (not included) to tap the wooden plug into the holes. Use a soft cloth between the wooden plug and the rubber mallet to prevent damage to the wood finish.



Step 6. Assembly is complete. Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.

Leveler adjustment: Levelers are pre-installed on the front legs. Adjust as needed to make sure the stool is level.



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY:

BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE.

THEY SHOULD BE INSPECTED AT LEAST EVERY 3 MONTHS AND RE-TIGHTENED AS NEEDED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY, AND ENSURE STABILITY.
