ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEPS	INSTRUCTION	ILLUSTRATION
1	Assemble Metal Legs (C) into Bookcase (A) by tightening the Flat Washer (F), Spring Washer (E) and Large Bolt (D) with Allen Key (G).	
2	Distribute 6 Adhesive Bumpers (H) around the frame evenly and position Glass Shelf (B) on top.	
3	Assembly completed	

ASSEMBLY TIPS:

Please check parts and hardware before assembling. Follow each instruction step by step.
 Place a protective pad or piece of cardboard on the floor while assembling your item on top of it.
 Remove all parts from the carton and separate them into part numbers/groups as indicated on the part list.
 Please follow instructions in the sequence as numbered to assure fast/easy assembly.

WARNING:

Don't attempt to repair or modify parts that are broken or defective - if you find a broken part please contact us for replacement.
 Keep all hardware parts out of the reach of children.

FURNITURE CARE:

Following these few basic steps will help to ensure that you enjoy your furniture for a long time:
 Do not expose your furniture to direct sunlight, dampness or any heat, like a hot cup of coffee or tea. Always use a coaster.
 Excessive exposure to sunlight may cause fading.
 Excessive temperature and humidity or cold may cause cracking or splitting.
 Dust with a clean, damp, lint free cloth.
 Use a damp cloth with water or mild detergent to clean all surfaces - do not use chemicals or paint thinner which will fade the surface.
 Place a piece of felt or a pad under the legs of your furniture to avoid scratching the floor.

Young children may be injured by tipping furniture and the use of a tipping restraint is highly recommended.

When properly installed, this restraint could provide protection against the unexpected tipping of furniture due to small tremors, bumps or climbing. We recommend mounting this restraint to a wall stud.

WARNING: This product is only a deterrent. It is not a substitute for proper adult supervision.

Installation Instruction:

1. Attach one of the mounting brackets securely near the top back edge of the furniture piece by inserting the short screw. Refer to picture A.
2. Determine the final position of the furniture piece. Mark location on the wall approximately 2" below the bracket mounted to the back of the furniture.
3. Drill a starter hole into the wall stud. If wall stud is not available, drill a hole into the wall and insert plastic anchor. Gently tap anchor until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.
4. Attach the second bracket by inserting and securing the long screw to the wall. Refer to picture B.
5. Align the two brackets.
6. Thread the strap through both brackets and tighten until snug.
7. Check to make sure that the brackets are firmly installed the strap is secure.
