










LSF 3-Seater with pull-out bed



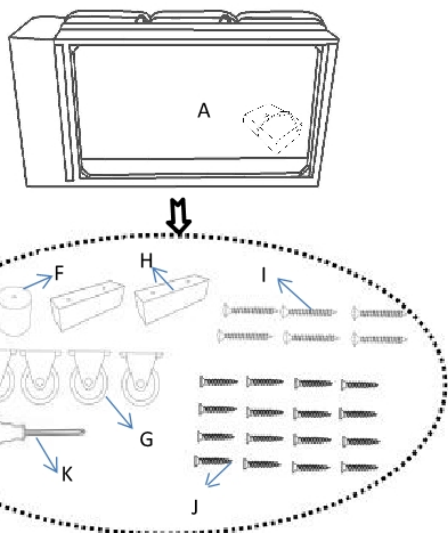
Legs and hardware are stored in the bubble bag and located underneath the trundle, please take out for assembly.

Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood

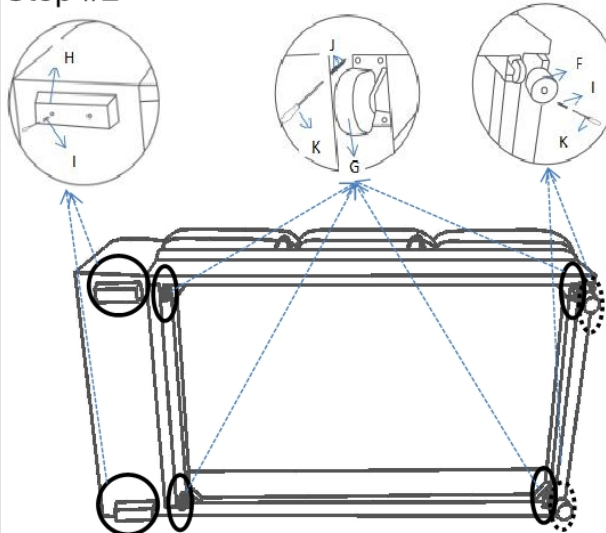








RSF Chaise with Storage



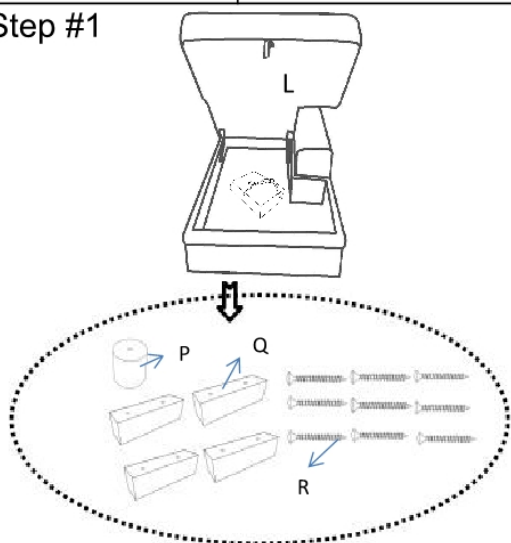
Legs and hardware are stored in chaise storage, please take out for assembly.

Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood

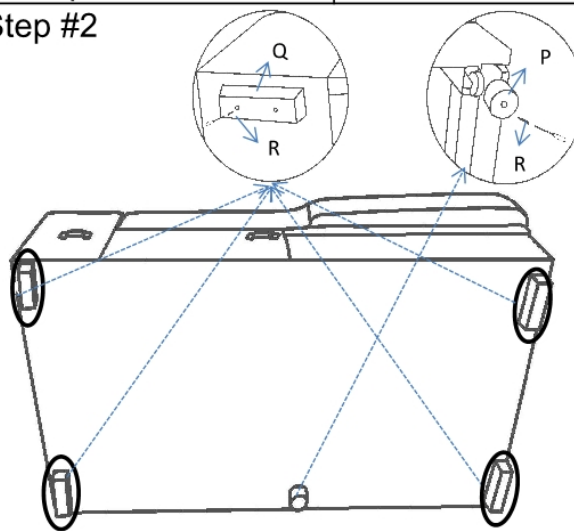
