Safety Information

Identify all the parts and hardware. Do not discard of the packaging until you have checked that you have all the parts and hardware required. Hardware package may have spare parts.

WARNING: This item contains small parts which can be swallowed by children and pets. Keep children and pets away during assembly. To avoid danger of suffocation, always keep plastic bags away from children and pets. We recommend that you assemble this unit on a carpeted floor to avoid scratches. If using power tools, set the tool to low torque to avoid damage.

May require 2 people for ease of assembly.

Care & Maintenance

This furniture is designed for indoor use.

Damage to furniture can come from temperature changes in relative humidity (RH) in our homes. Humid air oxidizes metal which results in rusting, corrosion, tarnishing and roughness. Wood absorbs water as relative humidity rises and falls, and in doing so it swells and shrinks.

To protect against the humidity effect, the metal is powder coated. The powder coat layer protects the metal from oxidizing, corrosion, tarnishing and scratching and keeps it looking good for years to come. The wood is sealed and lacquered to protect against humidity.

To help protect your furniture, follow these steps:

- Use a humidifier, preferably one with an automatic control system that can sense the humidity level and adjust itself accordingly
- Dust with a soft dry cloth
- Wipe up spills promptly
- Clean with a dry cloth
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, chemical solvents, strong detergents, cleaners with bleach, and furniture polish
- Use soft felt base coasters, placemats to help prevent scratches
- Keep furniture out of direct sunlight, which can cause cracking or roughness on the protective layer
- If it can be avoided, do not put furniture near heating vents
- Keep the furniture 3 to 4 inches away from the wall, giving heat and air space to circulate

Step 1



- I. Place Top Frames (F1) and (F2) on a flat, smooth surface and align with holes on Bottom Frames (G1) and (G2).
- Use Allen Key Bolts(2) and Washers (3) to attach.
 Use Allen Key (4) to tighten.

- I. Align holes on Shelf (A) with holes on assembled Top Left (F1) and Bottom Left (G1) Frames. 2. Use Allen Key Bolts (1) and Washers (3) to attach. 3. Use Allen Key (4) to tighten.

Step 3



I. Repeat same process as Step 2 to attach Shelves (B, C, D, and E).

I. Repeat same process as Step 3 to attach Shelves (A), (B), (C), (D) and (E) to the assembled Top Right (F2) and Bottom Right (G2) Frames.

Step 5



NOTE: Levelers on the bottom can be adjusted if floor is uneven.

Step 6



- I. Determine the location to place the Ladder Shelf against the wall and place a level on Shelf (A) to ensure it is even.
- 2. Use a pencil to mark spots on the wall at the top of the Top Frames (F1) and (F2).

Step 7



I. Measure the distance on the Top Frames (F1) and (F2) from the top to the brackets. 2. Using this measurement, mark another spot on the wall from the first spot marked.

Step 8



- I. Use a drill to pierce holes in the wall in the second spots marked.
- 2. Use a hammer to insert Wall Anchors (5) and align holes in brackets on Top Frames (F1) and (F2).

Step 9



- I. Place the Ladder Shelf against the wall and use a pencil to mark spots on the wall through the brackets of Shelf(C).
- 2. Use a drill to pierce holes in the wall in the spots marked.
- 3. Use a hammer to insert Wall Anchors (5) .

Step 10



- I. Place Ladder Shelf against the wall and align it with the Wall Anchors (5).
- 2. Thread Screws (6) through brackets on Top Frames (F1) and (F2) and Shelf (C) and insert into the Wall Anchors (5).
- 3. Use Phillips Screwdriver to tighten.
