Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach each post (P2) to the bottom of top frame (P1). **Note**: Make sure short section on the top of post (P2) is attached to the bottom of top frame (P1) as shown below. Securely tighten the posts (P2).



Step 2. Attach each long post (P4) to the short posts (P2) through the glass shelf frame (P3) following the label "Glass frame" on the shelf frame as shown below. Securely tighten the long posts (P4).



Step 3. Attach the feet (P6) to the long posts (P4) through the mirror shelf frame (P5) following the label "Mirror Frame" on the shelf frame as shown below. Securely tighten each foot (P6).



Step 4.

1) Turn the assembled bar cart to an upright position.

2) Place the clear plastic pad (H1) on each frame (P1,P3,P5) as shown below.

3) Gently lay the glasses (P7) on the top frame (P1) and glass shelf frame (P3), and lay bottom mirror (P8) on mirror shelf frame (P5) as shown below. Assembly is complete.
