(1) Vitreous China Sinktop

(1) Silicone


Step 1: PREPARING THE VANITY

Install the faucet into the pre-drilled locations of the sinktop (faucet and drain not included)

Follow the manufacturer's installation instructions to install the faucet and drain.

Do not over tighten the faucet system to avoid unnecessary damage to the vanity top.

See Figure 1.



Step 2: PREPARING THE TOP

The Vanity should be set in place per the manufacturer's installation instructions (Vanity not included)

Use a light damp cloth to wipe any dirt or dust from the top edge of the vanity.

Apply a small bead of silicone compound to the top edge of the vanity. The silicone compound will act as an adhesive to secure the top to the vanity.

Step 3: INSTALLING THE VANITY TOP

It is highly recommended to have a second person for this step.

Carry the sinktop to the vanity location and set the sinktop in place.

Place the sinktop into the final position as close as possible, avoiding moving the top excessively after setting into place.



STEP 4: DRYING TIME

Allow at least 24 hours for the silicone to fully dry.

During this time avoid moving the vanity top.
