## FURNITURE TIPPING RESTRAINT



### TOOLS NEEDED

Phillips head screwdriver (not included)

### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

NO.	ITEM	DESCRIPTION	QTY.
1		Screw 1.25"	4 pcs.
2		Anchors	4 pcs.
3		Nylon Strap	2 pcs.
4		Bracket	2 pcs.

1. Determine the final position of the unit. Mark location on the wall according to the prefixed brackets on the furniture.
2. Drill a starter hole into the wall stud. If wall stud is not available, drill a hole into the wall and insert plastic anchor. Gently tap the anchor until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.
3. Place the unit so the brackets on it are in line with the brackets on the wall.
4. Lace the supplied nylon straps through the wall brackets and on the unit brackets. Bring both ends together and slide the beaded end until it snap locks into the keyhole slot.
5. Check to make sure the straps are securely laced and locked to the brackets.
