- Please be advised that the warranty does not cover product failures resulting from improper installation.


- Please note that any damage, including chips and scratches, that occurs at the job site is excluded from the warranty coverage.


- Please **refrain** from overfilling the bathtub. Filling it beyond 1/3 capacity can result in overflow and create slippery conditions when entering the tub.
- Ensure that the floor is level and in good condition. An uneven surface may hinder the tub's correct installation.
- Clear any debris or trash from the installation area.













Drain Diagram




Drain & Flexible Hose Specification Drawings




Installation Instructions


1. Ensure that the floor at the installation site has sufficient floor support and is level.




2. Waterproofing the floor is highly recommended.




3. Identify the drainpipe's location on the floor by measuring the drain and waste positions beneath the unit. Clean the drain hole area in preparation for installing the drain, ensuring the area is dry and free from any debris.




4. Remove the bathtub from its box. It is recommended that the bathtub is carried by a minimum of two people. Make sure to carry and set down the bathtub only in the upside-down position.




5. Gently place the bathtub in the upside-down position on a tarp or cardboard sheet in order to avoid contact with any rough surface.




6. Loosen the nuts and washers from the metal frame. Adjust the leveling feet to align them with both the bathtub's bottom and the floor. Once aligned securely tighten the washers and nuts. Ensure that the bathtub base is elevated approximately 3/32 inches (3mm) above the floor, allowing it to rest on its leveling feet.




7. Be sure to mark all the positions of the leveling legs on the floor using a pencil. Then, move the bathtub into the desired location near the drainpipe.




8. Place your bathtub on two 4"x4" lumber pieces to allow access underneath for monitoring leaks. Position a tray beneath the bathtub to catch any potential water.




9. Remove the strainer by unscrewing it from the drain tee, which is included in a separate box with your purchase.




10. Take off the larger, lower rubber gasket. DO NOT TAKE OFF THE SMALLER, **UPPER GASKET.**




11. Place the strainer through the hole in the interior of the bathtub.



12. Take the lower gasket that was previously removed and re-attach it to the strainer from underneath the bathtub.




13. Take the drain tee and attach it to the strainer from underneath the bathtub. Tighten as much as possible.




14. Before continuing with the installation, push the pop-up into a closed position and fill the bathtub above the overflow (Note: Some models may not have an overflow) to check for any overflow or drain leakage. If there is any leakage, please halt the installation and reach out to customer service at 310-935-0028 or support@streamlinebath.com for further guidance and assistance.




15. Proceed to connect the supplied flexible drain hose to the bathtub drain. Subsequently, attach the hose to the drain coming from the floor in the home.




- a. Kindly be aware that the flexible hose is a standard method we offer for connecting to the end plumbing in a home. Given that plumbing installations vary in every home, we recommend consulting with a certified plumber to determine if the plumbing in your home is compatible with using a basic flexible hose.
- 16. Seal the connection by using a PVC pipe sealant to join the parts together.




17. Apply silicone along the bottom of the bathtub in order to create an airtight seal. Then apply a bead of tub & tile caulk around the edges of the base.



18. Now that the bathtub is in position, wipe away any surplus silicone or tub and tile caulk at the point where the bathtub meets the floor.



19. Allow for up to 24 hours for the adhesive material to set.

Proof of the original purchase is required to obtain a remedy under this limited warranty. Streamline® recommends using a certified professional for all installation and repair of kitchen and bathroom fixtures.

Streamline® will replace, free of charge, during the warranty period any part or finish that proves defective in material and/or workmanship under normal installation, use and service. Replacement parts may be obtained by emailing us at support@streamlinebath.com

This warranty is extensive in that it covers replacement of all defective parts and even finish, but these are the only two things that are covered. Labor charges and/or damage incurred in installation, repair, or replacement as well as any other kind of loss or damages are excluded. Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) from the original consumer purchaser must be made available to Streamline® for all warranty claims. This is the exclusive warranty by Streamline®, which does not make any other warranty of any kind, including the implied warranty of merchantability. This warranty excludes all industrial, commercial and business usage, whose purchasers are hereby extended a one-year limited warranty from the date of purchase, with all other terms of this warranty applying except the duration of the warranty.




WHAT IS NOT COVERED UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY

Use & Care Guide



In order to clean the bathtub, please only use a soft cotton cloth or soft sponge.



Never use acidic, alkali, or any products to clean the bathtub that state on their label that they are Not Suitable for use on Acrylic, ABS, Polystyrene or Plastic.



To clean inside the bathtub, fill it with warm water and add a couple of squirts of dish liquid. Allow it to sit for 30 minutes. Let the bathtub drain and wipe away any residue. You can also use cleaning products in aerosol cans or solvents, including acetone for a deep clean



In order to remove light marks or scratches, apply toothpaste to the area and scrub with a soft cloth or sponge.



If deep cleaning is necessary, rinse or soak the tub in warm water for 30 minutes and add a bit of liquid soap or dish soap to the water. Rinse and dry with a soft towel.



It is advised to clean the surface of the bath regularly in order to remove any insoluble products. Warm soapy water should be used and afterwards the bath should be wiped. **Do** not let cleaners soak in.



It is advised to always run some cold water before turning on the hot tap, with hot water temperatures not exceeding 65 Celsius.



If deep scratches or burns appear, please use sandpaper with at least 1500 grit. Dampen the sandpaper slightly with water and then proceed to rub the sandpaper in a circular motion around the affected area, ensuring that you rub slightly wider than the affected area.

Continue doing so until the scratch is no longer visible. In order to bring the affected area back to its shiny form, please use a soft cloth and a small amount of polish to buff the rubbed area. Continue doing so until the affected area is restored to its original shine.



The surface of the bathtub has good resistance properties to acids, but should not come into contact with alkalis or organic solvents, such as caustic soda. some multi-surface cleaners. bathroom cleaners, bleaches, harsh solvents, burning cigarettes, strong chemicals such as dry-cleaning fluids, paint strippers, acetone, citrus based chemicals, and nail/varnish removers.



Please read all instructions carefully before proceeding with installation.



Due to the complexity of the installation procedure, a professional plumber is required.
