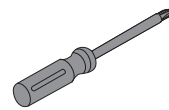

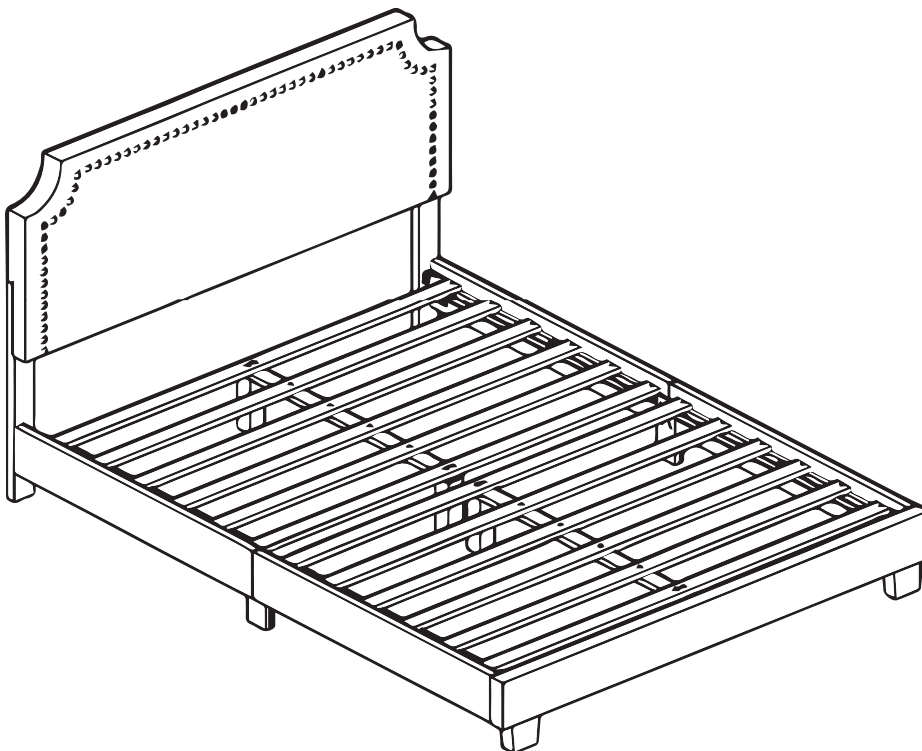

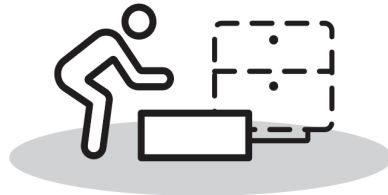
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

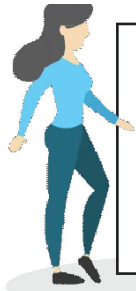
Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



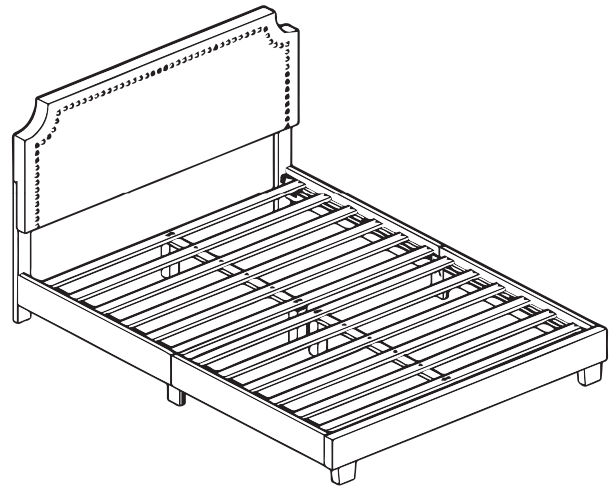
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

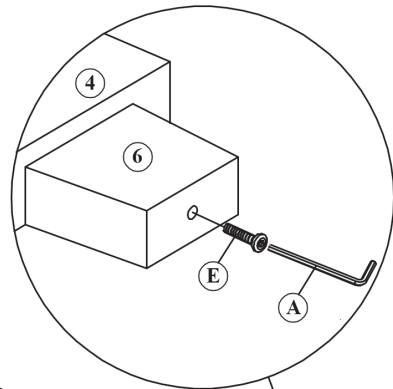
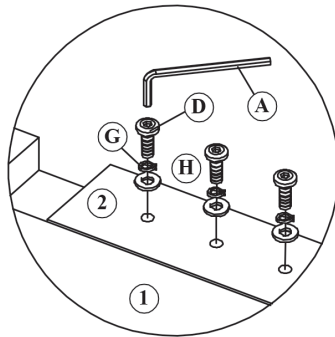
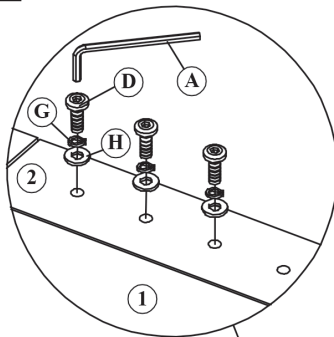
- Part #3L x 2pcs
- Part #3R x 2pcs
- Part #7 x 2pcs
- Hardware #C x 8pcs
- Hardware #A x 1pc

Attach the side rail leg (#7) to side rail (#3L/R) and secure by using Bolts (#C).

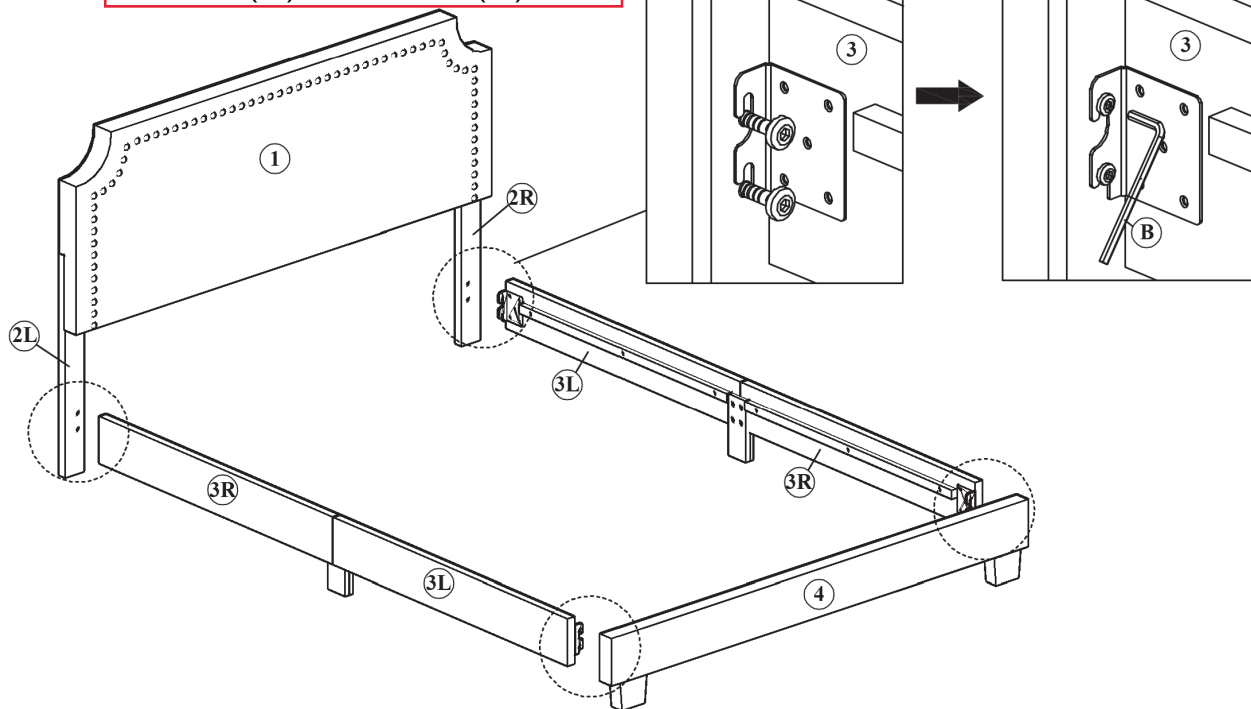
I. Attach the Headboard Leg (#2L,2R) to Headboard (#1) and secure by using Bolts (#D) with Spring Washer (#G) and Flat Washer (#H).

II. Align the Bed leg (#6) to the Footboard (#4). Secure by using Bolt (#E).

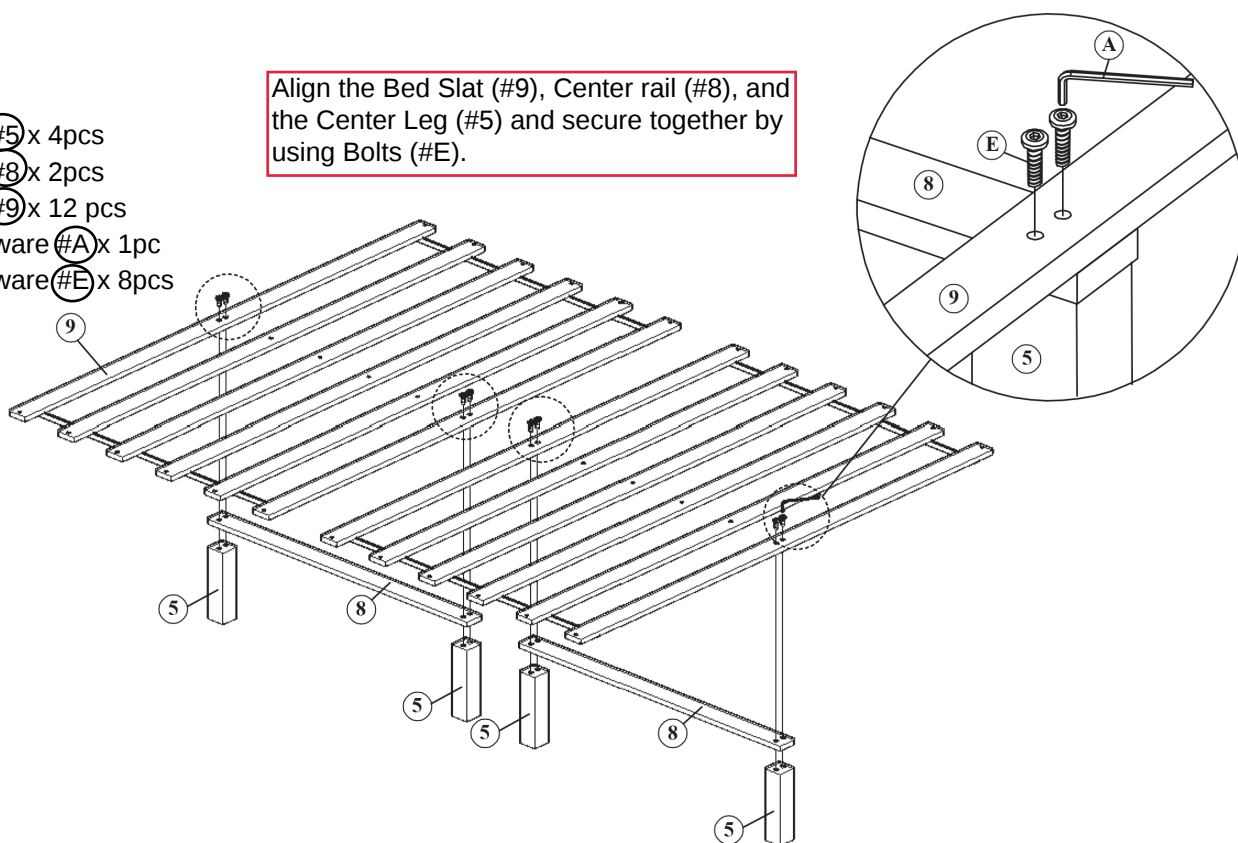
Align the side rail (#3L/R) in between the Headboard (#1) and Footboard (#4) and secure by using the bolts found on the Headboard (#1) and Footboard(#4).

Part #5 x 4pcs
Part #8 x 2pcs
Part #9 x 12 pcs
Hardware #A x 1pc
Hardware #E x 8pcs

Align the Bed Slat (#9), Center rail (#8), and the Center Leg (#5) and secure together by using Bolts (#E).

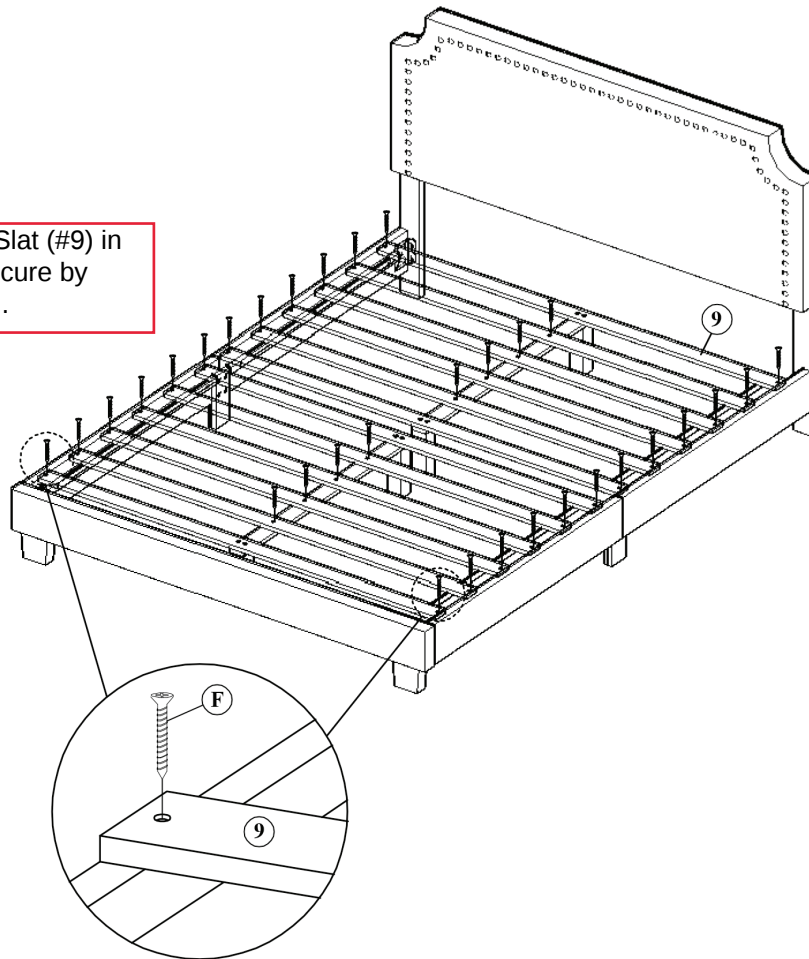

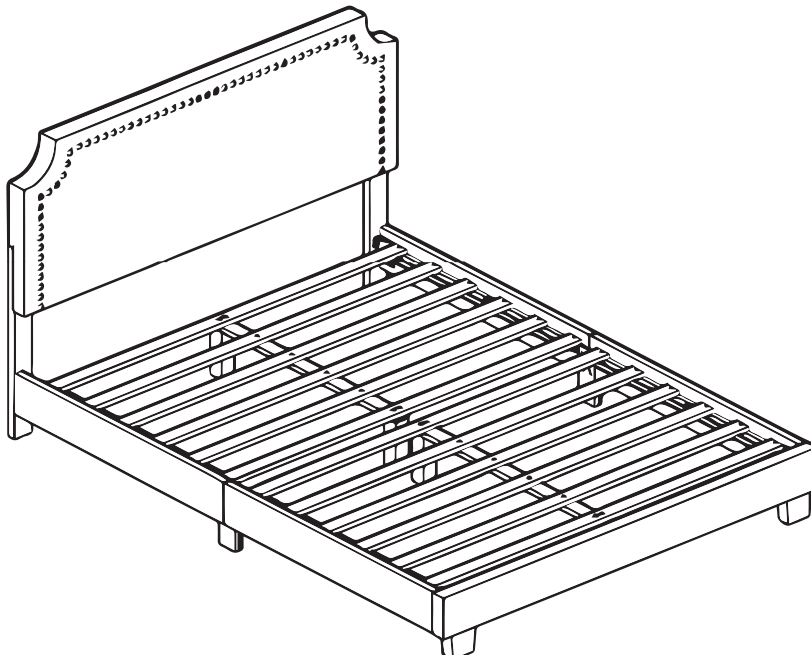

Hardware (#F) x 32pcs

Spread the Bed Slat (#9) in the frame and secure by using Screw (#F).
