(vertical and horizontal mounting options)

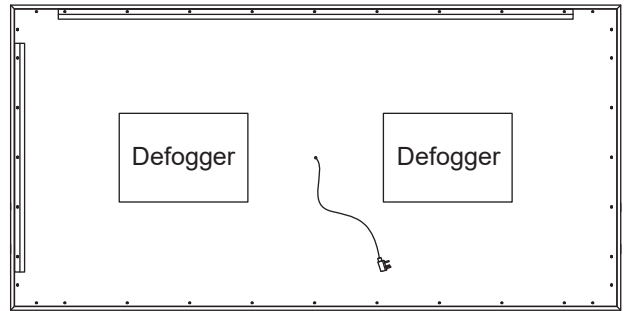

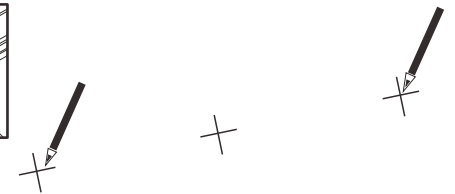
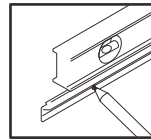
SUPPORT LOCATION

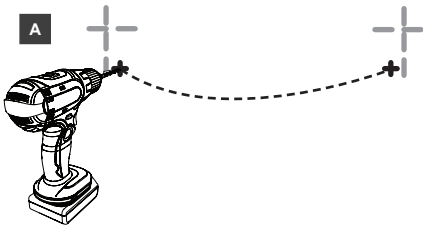

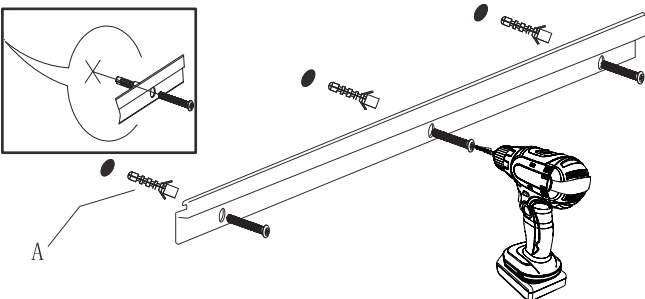
INSTALL SCREWS

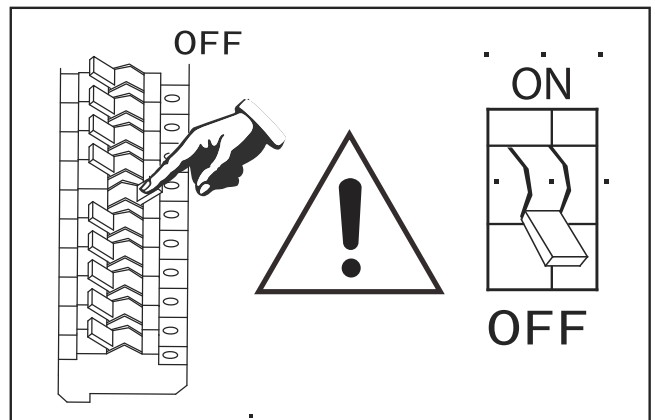

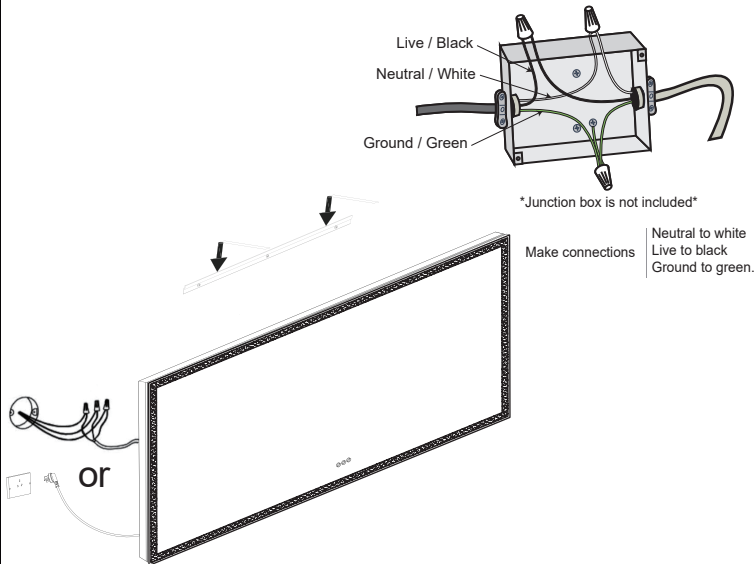

CONNECTION

Plug into the socket ,or cut off the plug then use the wire connector to connect the external power supply. (plug or hardwire connection options)

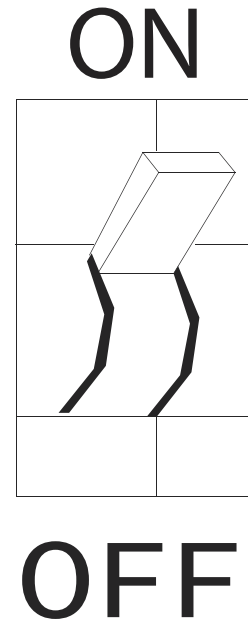


Warning: Strip wires to a suitable length. DO NOT connect the hardwire to a plug & socket outlet

TOUCH SWITCH SETTING UP

How to use Touch Switch:

Left Touch Sensor



Short touch to ON/OFF lighting.

Light brightness 10%-100% control by holding.

Release the button when the light reaches the desired brightness.



“Switch” sign

Middle Touch Sensor



Short touch to get the light temperature 6000K, 4000K and 3000K.

Long touch to adjust the light temperature from 6000K-3000K.

Release the button when the light reaches the desired color.

Right Touch Sensor



Short touch to turn ON/OFF the defogger.

The mirror is equipped with memory function to preserve the previous brightness/color settings.

***Suggestion:** The mirror is equipped with memory function to preserve the previous brightness/color settings.

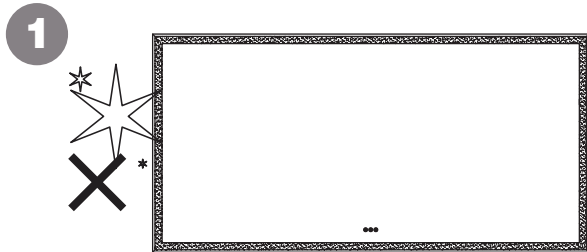
WARNINGS:

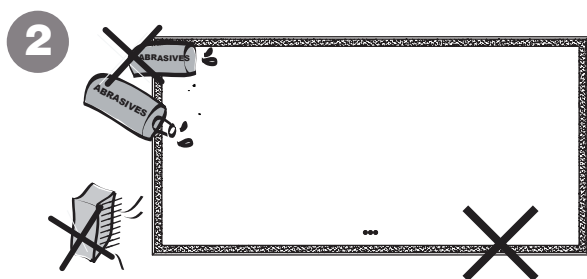

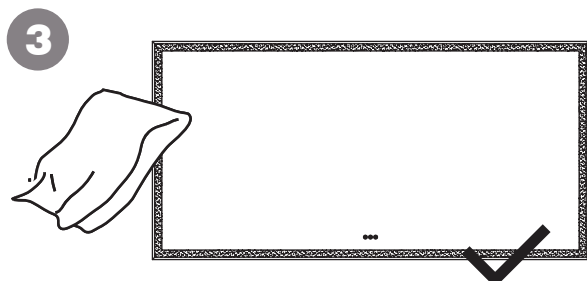
1. To avoid damage, do NOT knock the mirror with any hard objects;
