






Frequency of cleaning crystal

We know people who clean their crystal every few months, because they love handling the crystals and admiring them close up. Others do a cleaning every six or nine months.

To stretch the time between cleanings, dust lightly every two or three months with a feather duster, lambswool duster or make-up brush.

Frequency of cleaning depends on location of your Da Vinci and other environmental factors.

Crystal needs cleaning when it appears dusty or dull. Just look at your Da Vinci frequently (always enjoyable), and you'll know when it's time for a cleaning.

How to clean your Da Vinci:


Your Da Vinci is dishwasher safe!

- **1** Wash Da Vinci in its own cycle. Do NOT wash with silverware or dishes.
- **2** Carefully place crystal sections in dishwasher. Make sure that the crystal sections are not touching each other as this could cause chipping.
- **3** Use good quality detergent and anti-spotting rinse following the instructions of the dishwasher manufacturer. Cleaners with bleach or ammonia should NOT be used.
- **4** Allow crystal panels to cool before handling and reassembling your Da Vinci. If sections are brought directly from the hot dishwasher to a cold area, the drastic temperature change could cause crystal to crack.
- **5** Put on gloves to handle your now clean crystal sections. See page 4 for assembly instructions.



REPLACING CRYSTAL:


If a crystal breaks, you'll see a bare spot in the framework. You will need a set of needlenose pliers to replace the crystal. Make sure when placing pliers onto the metal tab that the ends of the pliers do not go beyond and scratch the crystal.




A Turn both tabs 90° counterclockwise on either side of pocket where the octagon should be.



B Slide crystal octagon into pocket. Turn both tabs clockwise back to original position to hold the octagon in place.





6 - G9 JCD (Supplied - Schonbek #JCD-G9-40) 40 Watts Max Install bulbs and be sure to test fixture BEFORE assembly.




To avoid damaging, do NOT touch bulb with bare ¹ hands. Install bulb with clean cloth or tissue.



How to Assemble Your Da Vinci Lamp:

Put on white cotton gloves to handle crystal.

- **3** Align arrows at top of one crystal section of the sphere (labeled "TOP").
- 4 Slide guide tab into slot to line up holes for locking pin.
- **5** To secure the crystal section, slide pin into hole. Push pin in until it seats. HOLD ON SECURELY TO CRYSTAL **SECTION UNTIL YOU ARE SURE PIN IS** ENGAGED.
- **6** Align holes on the bottom of crystal section with the screw on the bottom of the frame (labeled "BOT"). Tighten screw. Repeat steps 3 - 6 with other two crystal sections.
- **7** Assemble top by dropping in the crystal circle by aligning the (4) holes in crystal circle bottom plate with the (4) locating studs on top of frame.
- **8** Assemble bottom by screwing in bottom circle of crystal.



How to take apart your Da Vinci for changing bulbs or washing:

- 1 Remove top crystal circle.
- **2** Remove bottom by unscrewing large bottom crystal octagon.
- **3** Once the bottom crystal is completely unscrewed, remove the entire bottom circle of crystal. Da Vinci comes apart like an orange, in three sections.
- **4** Locate and remove screws on the bottom of the ball. Do NOT discard screws, they are required for reassembly.
- **5** Locate the locking pin inside the top of the
- **6** While holding one section of the ball, remove the pin by pulling it up. The crystal section can then be removed.
- **7** Remove the other two crystal sections in the same manner, so that all that remains is the frame with bulbs.
- **8** Replace necessary bulbs.

If you are cleaning your Da Vinci, all crystal parts can now be placed in the dishwasher. See page 7 for cleaning instructions
