Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the chair on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach the seat cushion (P2) to the back cushion (P1) as shown below.



Step 2. Loosely attach the left arm (P6) and the right arm (P7) to the assembled seat cushion (P2) as shown below.



Step 3. Attach the left arm (P6) and the right arm (P7) to the assembled back cushion (P1) as shown below.







Step 5. Attach the front legs (P3) and the left back leg (P4) and the right back leg (P5) to the assembled seat frame (P8) as shown below.



Step 6. Turn the assembled chair to an upright position. Make sure the chair is level and securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H7). Assembly is complete. **Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.**



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE INSPECTED AT LEAST EVERY 3 MONTHS AND RE-TIGHTENED AS NEEDED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY, AND ENSURE STABILITY.
