## **ATTENTION INSTALLER**

- Read these instructions carefully before installation. Inspect sink for damages. Do not install if the sink is damaged.
- Ruvati recommends that installation of sinks be done by a professional installer.
- 3. Sink edges may be sharp and can cause accidental injury to installer if not careful. Wear cut-resistant protective gloves during installation
- Templates are only provided as a guide. Place template on sink to ensure the 4. template will give you the proper cutout for the sink. Ruvati is not responsible for improper sink or countertop installation. Ruvati is not liable for any damages to sink or countertop or personal injury during installation.
- The instructions in this guide are for installation in a standard granite, marble, cultured stone or laminate countertop. For any specialty countertop follow recommendations of countertop manufacturer or fabricator.


#### MATERIALS AND TOOLS NEEDED


- Plumber's Putty
- Sink
- Sink Mounting Clips
- Silicon Caulk
- Philips Head Screwdriver
  - Jigsaw or Keyhole Saw
- Pencil
- Sink Cut-Out Template



#### **Additional Faucet holes**

1. The sink comes pre-drilled with 1 full hole for faucet installation as well as 3 additional half-drilled holes. If you need additional holes for either a 2- or 3- hole faucet, or for installing soap dispenser or air switch, you can open up any of these additional holes as well. We recommend using a 1-3/8" (35mm) diamond bit hole saw to drill through the half-drilled holes. In that way you get a clean cut. Turn the sink upside-down and gently drill through the hole. The half-way drilled hole makes it easy to place the drill bit and drill securely.





## UNDERMOUNT INSTALLATION

Alignment of sink to cutout is critical for a superior fit and finished look. Depending on your aesthetic preference, Ruvati sinks can be installed either with a 1/4" reveal, flush fit, or with a negative reveal. Decide on your prefence prior to installation.

### 1/4" Reveal


The countertop edge sits approximately **1/4" back** from the edge of the sink and exposes the rim of the sink.



The countertop meets the edge of the sink, **fitting flush** with the sink bowl.

### 1/4" Overhang

The countertop **extends 1/4"** over the edge of the sink on all sides.






NOTE: The following instructions are for solid stone countertop (granite, marble or cultured stone) countertops.

- Place template on countertop. Position it such that the sink will have proper clearance from cabinet.
- Trace a line around the template.
   Determine what "reveal" you want your sink to have (see previous page) and based on that, adjust the line accordingly. Cut along the line.
- 3. Turn the countertop upside down, and mark evenly-spaced positions for the anchors for the mounting clip. We recommend 3 mounting clips for the sink sides 20" and longer, and 2 mounting clips for the shorter sides.
- Using a 1/4" drill-bit equipped with a depth stop, drill 1/4" wide and 3/8" deep holes into the countertop. Tap the brass inserts into the holes, split end first.

a proper wood screw (not provided) instead of the stud. Screw the Mounting Clip securely to the wooden countertop)

(Note: If you are using a wooden countertop use

- Clean the underside of the countertop and the rim of the sink. Using a good quality silicone caulk, apply silicone caulk evenly around the rim of the sink.
- Place sink over the countertop opening. Attach the mounting clips and tighten the screws until mounting clips are snug against sink.
- Check alignment of sink to countertop opening and move slightly if you have to.
- 8. Tighten down screws evenly without overtightening. Remove excess silicone.

#### TOPMOUNT INSTALLATION

- Place the sink cut-out template on the countertop, where the sink is to be installed.
   Trace around the outside perimeter with a pencil (Figure 1). Note: Make sure you are using the top-mount template, and not the undermount
- After tracing, remove the template. Use a straight edge if necessary to straighten out the traced outline. Use a drill with a 7/8" spade bit to drill four pilot holes, one in each corner inside the outline. These holes will be your starting points for sawing the hole, so they must be large enough to fit the blade of a jig saw or keyhole saw.
- Cut the hole for the sink, using a jig saw to cut along the outline between each hole (Figure 2).
- Attach mounting clips to the sink body using the 2 short screws provided. Make sure the hooked side of the mounting clip is facing away from the sink (Figure 3).
- 5. Before installing the sink, place a bead of plumbers putty along the edge of the drain opening inside the sink and press the strainer body into place. Turn the sink upside down and tighten the strainer locknut with a wrench. While tightening, hold the strainer steady with pliers the keep it from turning. Wipe away any excess plumber's putty.
- 6. Fit the gasket on the sink drain pipe (tailpiece) and attach it to the strainer bottom with a slip nut. Tighten this nut by hand. For most threaded connections, apply a sealant such as plumbers putty, silicone tape or "pipe dope" to the threads to ensure a watertight connection.
- Attach the drain pipe assembly that comes with your sink.





- 8. Apply a "rope" of plumbers putty or caulk around the perimeter of the underside of the sink. Flip the sink over and carefully place it into the countertop opening, with all of the drains and attachments secured. Press down firmly to seat the sink against the countertop (Figure 4).
- Position the bottom of the mounting clip so that it is gripping the countertop. Use a screwdriver to tighten the screw until the mounting clip is snug against the countertop (Figure 5).
- After the sink is positioned and securely in place, place plumbers putty around the underside of the faucet body or its mounting plate and install it into the sink (Figure 6).
- 11. Attach all plumbing connections to the house drain line and water supply tubing. Apply a bead of silicone caulking around the perimeter of the sink where it meets the counter to seal any gaps. Fill the sink with water and leave it overnight to add weight and help it settle in place. Afterward, retighten the sink clips if necessary.





#### **Care and Maintenance**

- Clean regularly with dish-washing detergent and warm water.
- Make a habit of drying your sink after use. This is not necessary, but a good practice, and will ensure that no build up of limescale occurs.
- Food stains such as wine, coffee, tea, should be removed immediately using warm water and detergent. Stubborn stains can be removed by rubbing with alcohol and rinsed off with water.
- Never place extremely hot pots directly on the sink surface. Use a potholder. The bottom of a pot just removed from the burner can reach temperatures over 600°.
   C and can cause permanent damage.

- Never pour gasoline, acid, alkali, bleach or any solvents in general into or onto the sink because they can interact with the material of the sink and damage it.
- Never use a steel wool pad, or abrasive cleaning material to clean your sink. Doing so may damage the sink's surface and cause discoloration.
- Never let soap or other household cleaners dry on the surface of the sink. Most products contain additives which will affect the finish of the sink.
- **Never** use abrasive cleaning powders on the sink. This can damage the surface.
- **Never** let drain cleaners come in to contact with the sink.

#### RUVATI LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

This product has been manufactured and inspected to the highest possible quality standards. Ruvati sinks carry a limited lifetime warranty for residential use.

Should you experience any defects in materials or workmanship within the warranty period, we will repair or replace the defective product, subject to the following conditions:

- Any claim made under this warranty must include a copy of a valid proof of purchase showing the date and place of purchase.
- Our obligation under this warranty is to the original purchaser only, and may not be transferred.
- Product replacement does not include shipping costs or labor installation costs.
- This warranty applies to residential installations only.
- Ruvati reserves the right to examine product in question and its installation prior to replacement.
- If an identical replacement product is not available, Ruvati reserves the right to replace the defective product with a similar product.

NOTE: Accessories such as rinse grids, cutting boards, strainers are not covered by this warranty.

This warranty relates to defects in manufacture, materials or workmanship in a Ruvati granite kitchen sink supplied for installation into domestic premises in the United States. It does not extend to:
