Description: Porter End Table






### Important safety instructions:

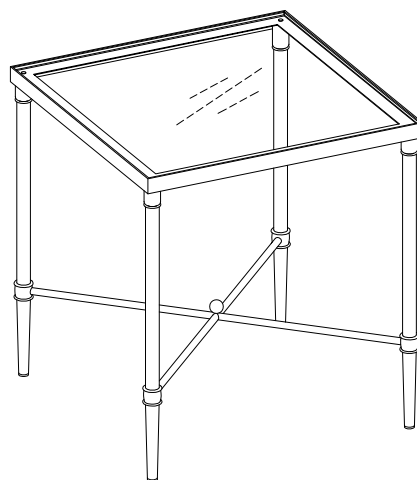
- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the table.

### Pre-assembly:



- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

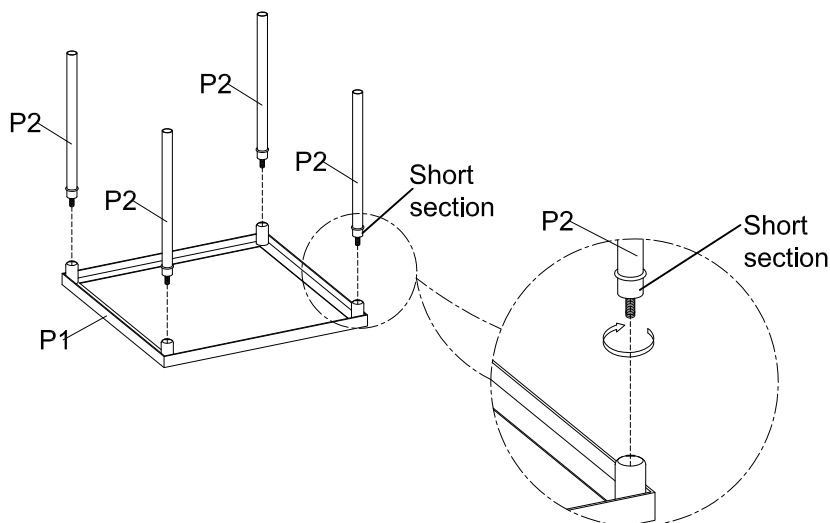

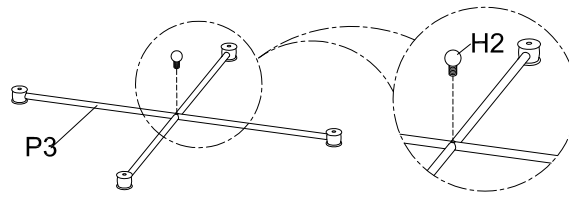
### Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach each post (P2) to the bottom of top frame (P1). **Note:** Make sure short section on the top of post (P2) is attached to the bottom of top frame (P1) as shown below. Securely tighten the posts (P2).

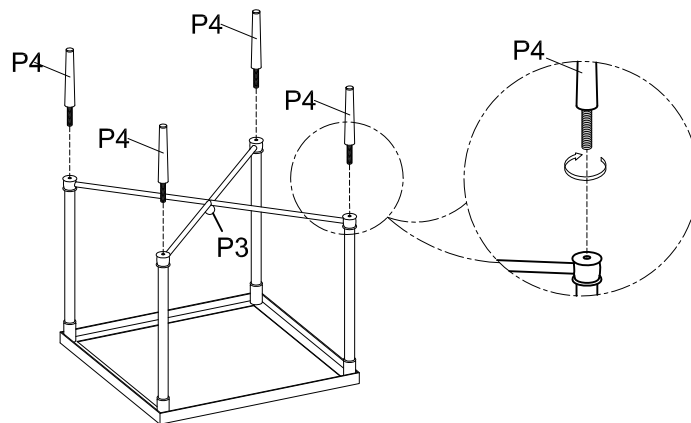


**Step 2.** Screw the finial (H2) to the "X" stretcher as shown below.

(H2) x 1 Finial 



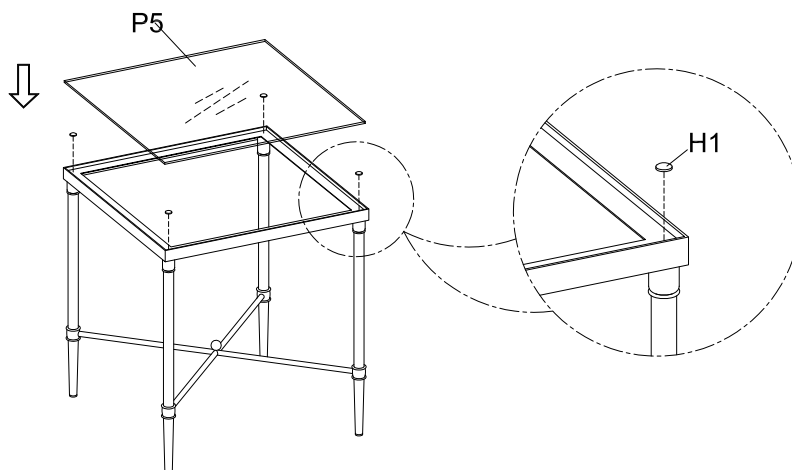
**Step 3.** Attach feet (P4) to each post (P2) through "X" stretcher (P3) as shown below. Securely tighten the feet (P4).



Step 4.

- 1) Turn the assembled table to an upright position.
- 2) Place the clear plastic pad (H1) on the top frame (P1) as shown below.
- 3) Gently lay the glass (P5) on the table top. Assembly is complete.

(H1)x4 Clear Plastic Pad
