


LEATHER POUF CARE INSTRUCTIONS




Dry microfiber cloth recommended to remove stains or spills.



To keep pouf soft, use a leather conditioner a couple of times a year.



In case of sticky residue, rub the affected area with an eraser.



Get rid of the peculiar leather smell by airing the pouf.



Professional cleaning recommended for deep stains and spills.



Overuse of water can lead to staining as leather has pores.




To avoid sagging and creasing of pouf with time, ensure inside is stuffed properly.



Before using leather cleaning products, test on a small, hidden spot. (Underside of pouf recommended)



While using pouf as a serving table, cover it to avoid spilling and heat absorption.



Keep away from direct sunlight and heat sources to prevent fading and cracking.



Use of hard/coarse brushes can leave damaging scratches on pouf.

Avoid the use of chemical cleansers




Don't let your pet sit on the pouf to keep your leather free of scratches and scars.
