

Prior to Installation

- Make sure that the cold and hot water lines are turned off
- Wrap all threaded connections with Teflon tape. Always wrap in a clockwise direction
- Cover your drain to avoid losing parts
- Do not disassemble the main faucet body, as it has been installed & commissioned correctly & precisely before delivery from the factory
- To keep the faucet from jamming, flush the water pipe before installation
- Using condition: Working pressure at 0.05-1.0MPa (including cold & hot water pressure) with applicable water temperature: 4°C-90°C





Safety Tips

- If soldering the water connections when installing the faucet, remove the O-rings, cartridges, and washers before applying any heat
- Protect your eyes with safety glasses when cutting or soldering





- Do not overtighten fixing screws/nuts. Tighten finger-tight, then use a wrench/screwdriver to tighten the fixing screw/nut until snug

FVS-1002 Installation Procedures



Step 1



Remove rubber washer (4), metal washer (5), mounting nut (6) and mounting screws (7). Keep the base trim ring (2) and base O-ring (3) on the base of the faucet.




Step 2




Screw and hand-tighten the hot and cold waterlines (8) into the faucet body (1), hot side left & cold side right when spout is facing up. Install the faucet body (1) through the 1-3/8" predrilled hole in the countertop. Attach the rubber washer (4), metal washer (5), mounting nut (6), and mounting screws (7) from underneath the sink.

Step 3




After adjusting the direction of the faucet body (1), tighten the mounting nut (6) until snug and then tighten the mounting screws (7) to the nut with a Phillips head screw driver until snug.

Step 4



Connect hot and cold waterlines (8) to the angle stops and tighten with a wrench. Unscrew the aerator cover by hand, and remove the aerator, then turn on the water to remove any leftover debris

Care & Maintenance




*To keep the product clean & shining, follow the steps below:

1. Rinse with clean water & dry with a soft cloth
2. Do not clean with soaps, acid, polish, abrasives, or harsh cleaners
3. Do not use a cloth with a coarse surface
4. Unscrew the aerator and clean when necessary


Usage

How to operate the handle:



Raise the lever handle to turn on the water. Push down to turn off.

Turn the lever handle to the left to increase hot water flow and temperature, turn to the right to increase cold water flow and temperature.



Trouble - Shooting

If you have followed the instructions carefully and your faucet still does not work properly, take the following corrective steps:

PROBLEM	CAUSE	ACTION
Leakage under the handle	Adjusting locking nut has come loose	Remove handle index button. Loosen set screw with hex wrench. Remove handle by hand only. Tighten locking nut with an adjustable wrench
Aerator drips or has inconsistent water flow pattern	Aerator is dirty or not seated properly	Unscrew aerator cap by hand. Remove aerator and clean out debris
Water will not shut off completely	Cartridge may be defective	Remove handle index button. Loosen set screw with hex wrench. Remove handle by hand only. Unscrew trim cap by hand only. Unscrew the locking nut with an adjustable wrench. Remove ceramic disc cartridge. Check for cracks
