
Assembly Instructions

Hallway Rack



NOTE TO CUSTOMERS:

- 1. For ease and speed of assembly we recommended that before you commence each step of the assembly that you identify all the parts required to complete that step.
- 2. We recommended that where possible you allow sufficient space to assembly the item as colose as possible to the place where it will be once assembled.
- 3. For the protection of youre furniture we recommended that the product is placed on protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
- 4. During assembly do not over tighten, as this may damage the product.
- 5. Please ensure you retain all the product packaging until the item completely assembled.
- 6. Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- 7. Please never allow any liquids to remain on your furniture as absorption can cause the wood to warp or finish to de-laminate.
- 8. It is recommended that this item should be assembled by two adults.








1).Attach Leveler (M) to Side Frames(A) & (B). 2).Assemble Frames(D) &(E) to Side Frames (A) & (B) using Washers (N) Long Bolts(P). Note:Do not tighten bolts until Step 4.




Attach Top Panel (C) to Side Frames(A) & (B) using Short Bolts(O).

Note:Do not tighten bolts until Step 4.




1) Tighten and Insert Lower Pole (I) into Side Frame (A&B), then insert Upper Poles (J) into Lower Poles (I) using Short Bolts (O). 2). Insert Plastic Caps (K) into the end of the Upper Poles (J).

Note: Do not tighten bolts until Step 4.



- 1). Attach Top Connecting Bar (H) to Upper Poles (J) using Short Bolts (O).
- 2). Attach Hooks (L) to Middle Connecting Bar (G) ,then attach it to Upper Poles (J) using Washers (N) and Long Bolts (P).
- 3). Attach Top Apron (F) to Upper Poles (J) using Washers (N) and Long Bolts (P).

Note: Tighten all bolts at this point.



Note: The weight load on the top panel should never exceed 100lbs, and the metal shelves should not exceed 20lbs.
