- For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that you identify all parts required for that step before begin. All items are to be assembled near the area which they will be placed in use to avoid moving the product unnecessary once assembled.

- For the protection of your furniture, we recommend that the product be assembled on a protected surface to prevent any damage. During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product. Always place the product on a flat and stable surface.

- PRODUCT FOR INDOOR, RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY
- ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED
- **DO NOT** throw away packaging material before you finish assembling to ensure that parts are not thrown out by mistake
- **DO NOT** use accessories or attachments that are not provided or recommended by manufacturer.
- **NEVER** force any parts or hardware into place when assembling.
- **KEEP CHILDREN** well away from plastic bags and packing materials this item was shipped in.
- SAVE these instructions for future reference.
- **DO** anchor product on the wall with at least 1 anchor in contact with stud.

#### **ASSEMBLY TIPS:**

1. Remove hardware from box and make sure all your parts are there, prior to assembly.

2. To avoid damage to parts and components, layout and asembly should be done on a flat surface.

3. Please check and distinguish each part before assembly.



## Step 2

- · Install Seat #2 and Mechanism #4 with Screw #C & #D.
- · Install Armrests #3 with Screw #A & #B.



## Step 3

· Install Backrest #1 with Screw E & F.



Note: all screws are pre-installed on the holes.

· Insert the upper Seat #2 into Gaslift #5.

## Care & Maintenance

#### FOLLOWING THESE FEW BASIC STEPS WILL HELP YOU ENJOY AND PROTECT YOUR INVESTMENT FOR YEARS TO COME.

Do not expose your furniture to any liquids.

All liquids should be wiped up immediately with a soft, slightly damp cloth in the direction of the wood grain. For stone surfaces, liquids should be immediately soaked up with a paper towel and wiped dry to avoid any staining. Avoid harsh commercial cleaners, glass cleaners and spray polishes on wood furniture.

Do not expose your furniture to strong or direct sunlight, near heat outlets or air conditioning units, open windows and dampness. Excessive exposure to sunlight and heat can cause fading of your furniture finish. Extreme temperatures and humidity changes can cause wood cracking and splitting.

Do not place rubber or plastic materials on the wood finish.

Chemicals within the plastic or rubber may react with the finish if left in contact for a long period of time. Place a strip of felt or cork under your accessories to avoid any markings.

Never place hot objects on any furniture surface.

Always place a hot plate between your furniture top and a hot object to protect your furniture.

Dust with a clean, damp, lint free cloth.

Frequent dusting will remove abrasive build up, which can cause damage a finish over time.

Small scratches and marks can be touched up or covered with a mark or scratch remover or a touch up stick. These can be purchased from any paint or hardware store.
