INSTALLATION & OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

TOOLS & MATERIALS REOUIRED

• Blade serew driver • Wire cutters • Adjustable wrench • Wiring supplies' as reguired by clectrical code · Stepledder.

CAUTION: Before assembling your lighting fixture. refer to the section taled. ELECTRICAL CONNEC-TIONS. If you feel you do not have electrical wiring, experience. refer to a do - it - yourself wiring handbook or have your fixture installed by a qualified licensed electrioian.

GENERAL

- 1. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
- 2. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances or the National Electrical Code. If you are unfamiliar with methods of installing electrical wiring, secure the services of a qualified licensed electrician.
- 3. These fixtures are intended to bo mounted to a 4"X 21/8" deep metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure.
- 4. Before starting the installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker of by removing the fuse at the fuse box, Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

NOTE: The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and sitions that may occur, It must be understood that common sense, caution and care are factors which cannot be built into any product. These factors must be supplied by the person(s)caring for and operating the fixture.

UNPACK THE FIXTURE Check the contents of the box. You should receive: · Mounting hardware package

· Glass diffusers (not supplied on all models)

• Plastic tip covers(one for cach diffuser, not supplied

on all models) Fixture assembly

PREPARE THE FIXTURE NOTE: FIRSTTURN OFF ELECTRICITY AD JUST THE CROSS BAR

Refer to figure I for illustration of fixture, parts and assembly

- 1. If you are replacing an existing fixture, disconnect and remove the old fixture. Expose the supply wiring from the outet box.
- 2. Fasten the mounting bracket to the outlet box using the atom is not attached to the mounting bracket, secure the stem with the lock washer and nut provided

- 3. Attach the finial(support loop) to the top part of the fixture. Turn the finial at least 3 complete turns to ensure proper securement.
- 4. Attach the chain to the finial(support loop)on the top of the fixture.Adjust the chain leaght by removing one link at a point boet suited to the location nad re-quired distance from the ceiling weave the wires through the china links. Attach the chain to the top finial loop place linial nut and canopy down the fix-ture chain Thread the wires up through the finial loop
- 5. Raise the fixture to the ceiling und weave the electrical while through mounting bracket threaded stem becure the top finial loop to the threaded stem by screwing loop into stem. Turn the loop at least 3 complete turns to ensure proper mounting. Now you are ready to make electrical connections.
- 6. Make clectrical comections SEE BELOW

ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

To make electrical connections:

Cut excess wire leaving six inches for electrical connections Split the wires into two separate leads, Connect the half of the STT cord that is ribbed surface, to the white wire of the supply circuit. Connect the smooth half of the wire (the half with markings) to the black wire of the supply circuit. Connect the bare copper wite to the supply circuit. Connect the bare copper wire to the grounding connectors of the supply circuit Use U.L. Listed wire connectors suitable for the size, type and number of conductors No loose strands of loose connections should be present. Secure wire connectors with U.L. Listed electrical tape.

FINAL ASSEMBLY

- 1. Stread the electrical splices so that the black wires are on one side of the outlet box and the white wires are on the other side.
- 2. Raise ceiling canopy and finial nut up to ceiling and secure to finial loop.
- 3. Make sure the weight of the chandelier is supported by the chain the electrical cord, If you install hooks for a swag, they too must engage the chain only. Installation of this type should not be made on a radiant heating type cating.
- 4. Install lightbulbs (not provided).

CAUTION:Refer to the relamping label located near the lampholder, for recommended wattage - do not exceed

- recommended wattage. Hang glass diffusers, Place plastic tips on ends of diffuner hooks.(Not ou all models)
- 6. Restore electricity and check the operation of you new lighting fixture.
