ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

CORNER LADDER BOOKCASE





This page lists all the contents included in the box. Please take the time to identify the hardware as well as the individual components to this product. As you unpack and prepare for assembly, place the contents on a carpeted or padded area to protect them from damage. Attach the Shelf (A, B, C, D, E) to the Back Post (F) using Bolt (J) with the Allen Wrench (K).



Insert Wood Dowel (I) into the Shelf (A, B, C, D, E). Attach the Right Post (H) to the Shelf (A, B, C, D, E) using Bolt (J) with the Allen Wrench (K).



Turn the assembled unit and insert Wood Dowel (I) into the Shelf (A, B, C, D, E). Attach the Left Post (G) to the Shelf (A, B, C, D, E) using Bolt (J) with the Allen Wrench (K).



- For your safety, please secure the product to the wall using the provided Anti-Tip Kit as per the instructions below.
 - 1. Attach 2pcs of Metal Bracket (O) to the holes on the back of the Left & Right Post (G & H) using Bolt (L) with the Allen Wrench (K).
 - 2. Choose the desired location for the furniture and mark the wall for the Metal Bracket (O). Drill 2 holes in the wall approximately 2" below the corresponding positions and insert the Plastic Anchor (N).
 - 3. Attach the other 2pcs of Metal Bracket (O) to the wall over the Plastic Anchor (N) using Wood Screw (M) with a screwdriver (not provided).
 - 4. Position the furniture so that the Metal Bracket (O) on the Left & Right Post (G & H) align with the Metal Bracket (O) on the wall.
 - 5. Connect the aligned Metal Bracket (O) with the Plastic Mounting Strap (P) and tighten as needed before locking them in place.



Cleaning & Care

Treat surfaces with care. Surfaces are resistant to scratches but are not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
