RESULTS

The prevalence of self-reported symptoms of depression, anxiety, and stress among male employees of the Atlanta-Fulton County Stadium is shown in Table 3. The prevalence of depression was 15.2%, anxiety was 22.1%, and stress was 28.3%. The prevalence of symptoms of depression, anxiety, and stress increased with age, marital status, education, income, and occupation. The prevalence of symptoms of depression, anxiety, and stress was highest among service occupations (60%), full-time employment (70%), and high school or less education (30%).
