

### Handle Removal Maintenance



using Allen Wrench and take off handle. using a small flathead screwdriver, unscrew set screw Turn off water and relieve pressure! Detach handle button

# Valve Cartridge Removal Maintenance



Remove handles. Unscrew Dome Cap counter clockwise by hand. Unscrew Retaining Nut using adjustable wrench, as necessary. Reassemble parts by reversing steps. take out cartridge assembly and inspect. Replace parts

### CAUTION: Maintenance

- Replacement parts may be available at the store where you purchased your faucet.
- N -Always turn off water and relieve pressure before working on your faucet.

## NOTES: Cleaning Instructions

- To keep the faucet clean, you should clean the faucet frequently and regularly. Clean the faucet with clear water or mild liquid, rinse the faucet with clear water and then dry the faucet with soft cotton cloths.
- Do not use any abrasive cleansers, cloths, or paper towel.
   Do notuse any acid or abrasive detergent.

### TROUBLE-SHOOTING


If you've followed the instruction carefully and your faucet still does not work properly, take these corrective steps

Water will not shut off completely.	Aerator leaks or has an inconsisitent water flow pattern.	Leaks underneath handle.	Problem
Dirty or worn outwasher in cartridge.	Aerator is dirtyor worn out or misfitted.	Cartridge has come loose.	Cause
Remove handle and cartridge to check if the washer is damaged permanently or dirty. Re-install cartridge.	Unscrew the aerator to clean or replace washer, or replace the aerator.	Tighten the cartridge.	Action







### INSTALLATION PROCEDURES




Remove any debris from valve outlets.


Turning off the water supply valves. This is usually found near the water meter. If you are replacing an existing faucet, remove the faucet from the sink and clean the sink surface thoroughly.




Install without Deck Plate. Make sure the O-RING is placed onto the bottom of Base Ring. Install faucet through hole in sink. From underside sink, attach mounting assembly Position faucet on sink properly and tighten Mounting Nut.




Install with deck plate. Assemble mounting screws onto underside of deck plate. Position deck plate onto 3-hole mount of sink. From underside of sink, tighten plastic mounting nut. Make sure the O-RING is placed onto the bottom of Base Ring of faucet. Install faucet through hole in deck plate. From underside of sink, attach mounting assembly. Position faucet on deck plate properly and tighten Mounting Nut.



If necessary, tighten screws using a adjustable wrench until the faucet is firmly connected to the sink.




Connect hot and cold water supply lines to the Water Supply Valves.




Lift the handle up, the cartridge will be activated allowing water to flow. The water flow will increase by continuing to rotate handle. By rotating the handle to the right, the water temperature will decrease to cold flow only. By rotating Handle to the left, the water temperature will increase to hot only

After installation is complete, remove aerator and rehandle to the closed position. Turn on the water supvalves, and check all connections for a leak. Turn o your faucet and allow both hot and cold water to rulleast one minute each. Replace Aerator.
