





STOP!


Before beginning the assembly process,

Fix Left Side③and Right Side④into Front Leg①and Back Leg②




Fix the height-adjustable feet L on the bottom of Front Leg①and Back Leg②




Fix Bottom⑤on the Front Leg①& Back Leg②and Left side③and Right side④




“Pay attention on the direction of Bottom⑤ there's a hole at the back




Fix Bottom⑤with Front Leg①and Back Leg②by Screw A




- 1- Turn the cupboard to stand
- 2- Fix Left Middle⑥and Right Middle⑦on positions as below





“Pay attention on the direction of Left Middle⑥ and Right Middle⑦. The groove is at the front side”

- 1- Fix Left Middle⑥with Bottom⑤by Screw A
- 2- Fix Right Middle⑦with Bottom⑤by Screw A




STEP 4

- 1- Turn the cupboard with the back side upwards
- 2- Fix Column⑧with Left Side③and Right Side④





Fix Column⑧into the holes on Left Side③and Right Side④by Screw A




“Pay attention that the Column⑧ is stuck into the grooves of Left Middle⑥and Right Middle⑦”

STEP 5

Fix Left Back ⑨, Middle Back ⑪ and Right Back ⑩ as positions at the back




Fix Left Back ⑨, Middle Back ⑪ and Right Back ⑩ with Left Side ③, Right side ④, Left Middle ⑥ and Right Middle ⑦ by Screw A




STEP 6

- 1- Turn the cupboard with the front side upwards
- 2- Put Shelf 12 and Middle Shelf 13 on positions as below




Put Shelf 12 and Middle Shelf 13 down and totally stuck into the slots of Left Side 3, Right Side 4, Left Middle 6 and Right Middle 7





Put Top ⑭ on the top








- 1- Fix Handle C on Left Door 15 and Right Door 16 by Screw B
- 2- Insert Magnet D into holes on the doors
- 3- Insert Part E at the bottom of doors













- 1- To assembly the doors, fit Lower hinge bolt F of Left Door 15 into the hole on Front Leg 1 and make Gasket G between Left Door 15 and Lower hinge bolt F
- 2 - Pull the upper hinge bolt of Left door 15 down, align the door and release the upper hinge bolt to fit the hole of Top 14
- 3- Repeat the step for Right Door 16



STEP 9



- 1- Mark the wall holes by a pencil
- 2- Drill the wall where marked on the wall
- 3- Insert Part J (plastic expansion bolt) into the holes
- 4- Use the hammer to insert part J until it overcomes the wall
- 5- Fix Part H at the Left back ⑨ and Right back ⑩ with wall
