



1. Place the table on its side on the floor. [Fig 1]
2. Assemble the bases on each side of the bottom of the table by using two M4 Screws [Fig 2, 2A,] and four M6 Screws per base. [Fig 2B]
3. Unlock the chain from the hook under table top , and then insert it under top shelf. [Fig 3, 3A]
4. Unfold the table [Fig 4] , and then stand up. [Fig 5]
5. Fold down the top shelf. [Fig 6]
6. Lock the top shelf in place using locks on both sides. [Fig 6A]







Safety Tips

- Use caution when cleaning or handling to prevent risk of injury from exposed metal edges.
- Do not overload the table or shelf.

Cleaning

- Before use, remove protective film then clean the table.
- Clean the table using a cleaning agent suitable for use with stainless steel and galvanized surfaces.
- Always remove cleaning agent residues, as this can discolor the surface.
- Never leave any surface damp as this may cause discoloration. Wipe dry thoroughly.
