


Ivy 8-Bar Electric Towel Warmer

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PARTS/ASSEMBLY (PLUG-IN):


1. Leg mounts

S. Leg grommet




PLUG-IN INSTALLATION:

1 Prepare the frame and legs


- Attach 3 leg mounts by inserting the long bolts and their washers into the leg inserts on the side of the leg and securing to the armer using the medium hex key.
- Make sure the locking screw faces towards the bottom of the warmer. Add additional washers if the leg is not tight against the unit.




2 Prepare the frame and legs

- Remove the leg insert (3) from the power leg mount (9) by unscrewing the set screw using the medium hex key (11) and push out the insert from the other end.
- Slide the leg grommet (13) all the way up the cord and align with the slot in the power leg mount.
- Reinstall the leg insert into the power leg mount and secure using the set screw (2).




3 Mount warmer (plug-in option)

- If aligned with a wall stud, there is no need to drill a hole. Simply place a wall screw (6) into a wall flange (7) and screw directly through the drywall and into the stud.
- If not aligned with a stud, drill a $\frac{7}{32}$ " hole through the drywall. Insert a drywall anchor (8) and tap it in with a hammer until flush with the wall. Now insert the wall screw (6) until the wall flange (7) is snug against the wall.





4 Mount warmer onto flanges

- With all flanges (7) now installed on the wall, mount the unit onto the flanges until the legs are wall seated into the flanges. The leg set screws (2) under the legs may need to be loosened.
- While applying pressure on the unit to keep the legs in the flanges, tighten each of the set screws using the medium hex key (11) until the legs are secure (don't over tighten).
- Plug the warmer into a properly grounded 120V wall outlet and your warmer is ready for use.





HARD-WIRED INSTALLATION:





1 Install power leg flange

- Ensure there are no obstructions behind the wall. Drill a 1/2" hole through the drywall at the wall marking made earlier.
- Insert the wall bushing (10) through the power wall flange (11) and screw the bushing into the hole you drilled into the drywall. Screw the bushing until it is snug and the small holes in bushing are aligned vertically.





2 Thread power cord through leg

- Remove the power leg mount (1) using the medium hex key (M) and cut the power cord near the plug and off the leg grommet.
- Thread the cord throughout the power leg and insert the short leg bolt (9) and washer from the opposite end through the internal bracket.
- Secure the power leg to the warmer by tightening the bolt using the medium hex key (M). If the leg does not get tight enough, add washer as required.



3 Insert power cord and mount warmer on wall

- While holding the warmer near the wall, insert the power cord through the wall bushing (10) and pull the cord tight from within the wall cavity.
- Position all the legs onto their respective flanges and press the warmer firmly into the flanges. While applying pressure, tighten each of the 4 set screws (2) using the small hex key (P) until the legs are secure (do not over tighten).
