REGINA ANDREW THOUGHTS ON WIDTH:
Multiple hallway, living or dining room sconces should accent the space with an adequate amount of ight based on between each fixture.

Beside A Bathroom Mirror REGINA ANDREW THOUGHTS ON HEIGHT: no order to have even illumination across a mirror from side placed sconces, space the
fixtures 60 - 65 " from the floor to the center of the backplates.

Above a Bathroom Mirror REGINA ANDREW THOUGHTS ON WIDTH:
The ideal linear sconce for above a bathroom
nirror should be $3 / 4$ the width of the mirror without
extending over each side.
