- DO NOT exceed 80lbs for the tabletop, evenly distributed.

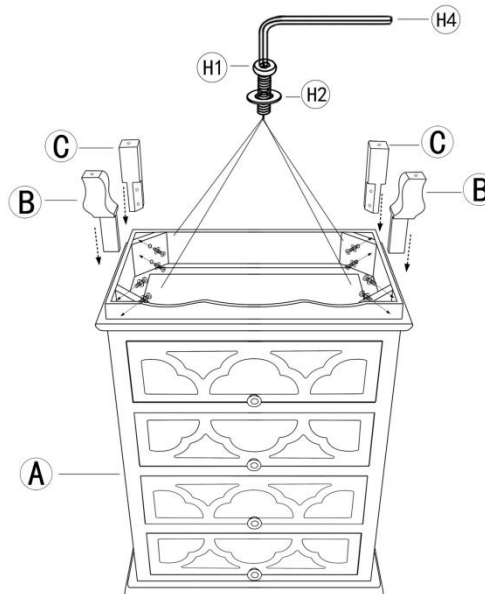

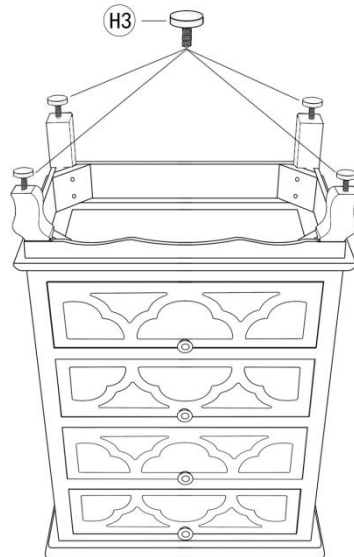

Step 1: Put the Tabletop (A) on a soft surface to protect the finish.

Attach the Legs (B) with Hex bolts (H1) and Washers (H2) using Allen key (H4) as below photo shown. Ensure the Legs (B) are closer to the front, and Legs (C) are closer to the back.



Step 2: Attach the Foot pads (H3) to the bottom of all Legs as shown below.
