

Lacquer or Poly Whey Finish Care Guide

Please use this information sheet as a guide when caring for your Kingston Krafts furniture item.

HOW TO CLEAN

Use only a soft non-abrasive cloth dampened with clean water. A mild detergent, like liquid dish soap, can be used when needed for antibacterial purposes, but it is not necessary for everyday cleaning. The coating provides immediate protection from spills, however, to prevent blemishes in the finish any spills such as from beverages, acidic liquids, and foods should be wiped up immediately with a damp cloth.

NEVER use products that contain bleach, vinegar, ammonia, or any chemical or oil based cleaner, as we cannot guarantee what reaction may occur within each household product. This includes but is not limited to products like Pledge, Orange oil, Murphy's wood oil or any other wood polishing product. These products will create a buildup of oils that simply rest on top of our applied finish as the oil will not be able to penetrate the sealed wood. This buildup can break through the finish over time and cause blemishes.

NEVER polish with wax or use any wax based products.

NEVER use any product that contains acetone. Acetone is used to remove lacquer and to thin lacquer. Household products, like nail polish remover contain acetone. Never place items like cotton balls with nail polish remover on your lacquered finish.

Hitting the lacquered finish with hard objects, including kicking with shoes and heels should be avoided as our finishes do not prevent dings and dents.
