


CARE AND MAINTENANCE





PREPARATION

<p>STEP1 TAKE OUT LEGS AND HARDWARE WHICH PLACED ON THE UNDERSIDE OF THE SEAT</p>	<p>STEP2 PUT THE WASHERS ON THE BOLT IN THE ORDER SHOWN IN THE PICTURE</p>	<p>STEP3 INSERT THE FRONT LEGS AND SCREW IN THE BOLTS BUT DON'T TIGHTEN COMPLETELY</p>
		
<p>STEP4 INSERT THE BACK LEGS AND SCREW IN THE BOLTS BUT DON'T TIGHTEN COMPLETELY</p>	<p>STEP5 PUT THE CHAIR UPRIGHT AND MAKE SURE ALL LEGS ARE LEVEL, THEN FIRMLY TIGHTEN BOLTS WITH SPANNER WHILE THE CHAIR IS UPRIGHT AS PICTURED ABOVE</p>	<p>STEP6 FIX THE BLACK FABRIC ON THE UNDERSIDE OF THE SEAT, THIS ITEM MAY REQUIRE PERIODIC TIGHTENING</p>
