The diagram shows the internal anatomy of the human eye. Which part of the eye is responsible for focusing light onto the retina?
A. Cornea
B. Iris
C. Lens
D. Retina

ANSWER
C. Lens
The lens is responsible for focusing light onto the retina. The cornea also refracts light, but the lens provides the primary focusing power. The iris and pupil control the amount of light entering the eye, and the retina is the light-sensitive layer that receives the focused light.
