

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

# **Install the Fixture**



- If necessary, remove the nipple, hex nut and large cap from the fixture body.
- 2 Pull the fixture body and bracket apart and insert the shade between them as shown in the diagram. NOTE: Make sure the trim with the step is on the top of the shade. Then insert the threads of the shade into the top and bottom holes of the bracket.
- 4 Adjust the shade until straight. Screw the nipple into the bracket and the fixture body and secure them in place using the hex nut, then tighten all the small and large cap nuts.
- Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 6 Install the cover to the top of the shade.
