INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Glass Vessel Sinks

Please Note:

- Review and abide by all building and plumbing codes.
- Novatto sinks need to be installed by a professional.
- Some counters require different cutting methods; seek the details of your chosen countertop material.
- Check to make sure the sink is sealed watertight.


Novatto's vessel sinks can be installed sitting on the countertop or recessed - up to a third or even half of the sinks height. You may want to figure out your ideal vessel sink height before you begin. The finished height is a personal preference. Most vanity heights are set at 30"-32". After a vessel sink is mounted on top of the counter, the vessel height will be 34"-36" unless it has been recessed.

Steps to Complete Your Project

- Layout and place the sink and faucet of your choice in the desired location. Using a pencil, mark the bottom of the sink hole and faucet base. Consider the flow of the faucet when marking the location.
- Drill the countertop for sink drain opening with a 1 5/8" drill bit.
- Place the vessel on top of the counter and make sure the drain fits down inside of the counter. If a mounting ring is preferred, Novatto provides them in three finishes to match the faucet and drain. The mounting ring elevates the sink ½". It also provides stabilization and more cleaning room underneath the vessel. Due to design considerations, a mounting ring is not always necessary. To lower the height of the sink, simply enlarge the hole. The larger the hole, the more stability you will also achieve in installation.
- Use a bead of clear silicone to seal between the outside edge of vessel where it is mounted to the mounting ring or counter.
- Use a level to ensure the vessel is level in every direction and install the drain.
- Secure the vessel to the counter with fastener on the drain. Be sure to not over tighten the drain assembly. Hand tightening will be sufficient. The breakage seen with vessels is usually related with improper installation of the drain.

When cleaning up after installation, do not use abrasive cleaners. Ideally, the best way to care and keep your sink like new is to protect it with **Glacier Ice.** This nanotechnology will prevent any hard water spots or oxidation on the sink <u>and</u> faucet. For everyday cleaning simply use a soft cloth, soap and warm water.

TROUBLESHOOTING TIPS

<u>lssue</u>	Reason	Solution
Sink wobbles or is loose	Mounting ring not used; drain is loose	Use mounting ring with silicone; tighten drain
Does not completely drain	Pop-up is too high, wrong seal used	Make sure correct seal is used and is below bevel
Leakage under sink	Drain has come loose	Tighten the fastener under the countertop

Glacier Ice

Novatto's glass vessel sinks are incredibly easy to clean and maintain. To keep glass sinks in pristine condition simply wipe down with a soapy sponge or soft cloth, rinse and dry. A glass cleaner such as Glacier Ice or any other non-abrasive glass cleaner may be used if grime or minerals build up.

Caution: Do NOT use metal brushes, scouring pads or any abrasive cleaners when cleaning glass sinks as this may scratch the glass. If the bottom of the glass sink is hand painted use basic soap and water as other cleaners may discolor or damage the paint.

Due to the unique hand crafted quality of Novatto's painted glass sinks; color, variance and design pattern may vary from sink to sink. Tempered glass is a glass processed by controlled thermal or chemical treatments to increase its strength as compared to normal glass. Novatto's in house testing have found them very durable and forgiving. Normal items such as toothbrushes, small jewelry, bottles, etc. will not break a Novatto glass sink. Novatto recommends using a professional plumber when installing your glass sink. Do not allow the glass vessel sink to come in contact with steel or other glass objects which could scratch or damage the sink.

What is the best way to care for my Novatto glass vessel?

Ultimately, the best way to care and keep your sink like new is to protect it with **Glacier Ice**. This nanotechnology will prevent any oxidation or hard water spots on the sink <u>and</u> faucet. For everyday cleaning simply use a soft cloth, soap and warm water.

Is there a template available for the glass sinks?

We always recommend using the actual sink for desired placement before making any cuts in the counter.

May I use a drain or mounting ring from another vendor?

Yes, drains and mounting rings from other manufacturers will be compatible with our glass vessel sinks.

Is the drain or mounting ring included with my purchase?

It may be, we offer our sinks individually or as a combo. Double check your purchase for details. We recommend using a pop-up drain and mounting ring, for added stability, with our glass vessel sinks.

Do these glass vessel sinks have overflows?

No, none of our glass vessel sinks have overflow holes.

How durable is Novatto's high tempered glass?

Tempered glass is a glass processed by controlled thermal or chemical treatments to increase its strength compared to normal glass. Our in house testing has found them to be very durable and forgiving. Normal items such as toothbrushes, small jewelry etc., will not break a Novatto glass sink. High tempered glass is regarded as safe glass, meaning if it breaks it will disintegrate into small blunt pieces.
