

Instructions:

- 1. Measure distance X from the bottom of the strainer to the bottom of the wide area in the P-trap.
- 2. If needed, cut tailpiece to length, using a hacksaw or a tubing cutter.
- 3. Slide nut (A) onto the tailpiece.
- 4. Place rubber washer on top of the lip of the extension.
- 5. Thread nut onto the strainer.
- 6. Once all the P-trap connections have been made, let water run into the drain, check for leaks.
