Overview of Home Renovation in 2022 and 2023



Big Ideas



UNDERTAKING ENERGY-EFFICIENT UPGRADES

Almost half of renovating homeowners cite improving energy efficiency as highly important when completing home improvements (46%) and upgrades to windows or skylights, roofing and insulation have increased steadily since 2020 (27%, 21% and 16%, compared with 20%, 16% and 12%, respectively). One in 7 renovating homeowners purchased solar power systems (15%) increasing 2 percentage points since 2020 (13%).

KITCHENS AND BATHROOMS REMAIN A PRIORITY

Interior spaces are the most popular areas to renovate (77%), followed by improvements to outdoor areas and adding extensions (57% and 18%, respectively). Kitchen and master bathroom projects remain a priority during renovations (33% and 25%, respectively) and command the highest median spend at \$30,000 and \$19,000, respectively.

UPGRADES TO HOME SYSTEMS

With more than two-fifths of the surveyed homeowners living in homes built in 1980 or earlier (42%), homeowners are focusing on home system improvements. Over a third of renovating homeowners upgraded electrical in 2022, closely followed by plumbing and cooling systems (36%, 33% and 27%, respectively).


PROFESSIONAL DEMAND CONTINUES

Demand among renovating homeowners for professionals continues to grow (94%, compared with 91% in 2020). Among professionals hired, electricians, plumbers, painters, and carpenters were the most common (72%, 60%, 44% and 43%, respectively). Tile, Stone or Benchtop professionals saw the most significant increase in demand, rising 14 percentage points year on year (38%, compared to 24% in 2021).

Median Annual Renovation Spend (AUD\$) by Generation





Chart shows the frequency of planned activities in 2023, related to the primary home, as reported by homeowners on Houzz Australia.


Planned Activities in The Home in 2023





How We Are Funding Our Home Renovations


Charts show the frequency of top five funding sources for home renovations, overall and by age, as reported by homeowners who renovated their primary homes in 2022.



Top 5 Challenges that come up during renovation





Charts and tables show the average number of upgrades during home renovations in 2020, 2021 and 2022 overall and by age, as reported homeowners who renovated their primary homes.





Methodology



APPROACH

Houzz is an all-in-one resource for homeowners working on a home renovation or decorating project. Our large and engaged user community is able to provide unprecedented insights on the latest market trends based on users' home improvement activity. We aggregate and share these insights with the community to give people greater confidence in the choices they make for their homes, and to give home professionals greater insights into their clients' wants and needs. With these goals in mind, Houzz conducted an online quantitative survey of registered Houzz users regarding trends in home improvement and design, fielded between December 2022 and March 2023. The annual Houzz & Home study is the largest survey of residential renovating, building and decorating activity conducted. This survey covers every aspect of home renovation in 2022, from interior renovations and extensions to home systems, exterior upgrades and outdoor projects. This includes the historical and planned spends, professional involvement and motivations behind these projects, as well as activities planned for 2023.

COMPLETES AND QUALIFICATIONS

The 160-question survey gathered information from Houzz users who identified themselves as 18 years old or older and homeowners. The final sample consists of 1,581 respondents in Australia. The current report relies on a subset of responses, i.e., Australian homeowners on Houzz (n=1,511) and Australian homeowners on Houzz who renovated their primary residence in 2022 (n=698).

SAMPLING AND WEIGHTING

Data was gathered via an email sent to registered Houzz users. The link invited homeowners to tell us about their homes. Respondents were notified that aggregate findings would be shared with the larger Houzz community to help others in completing their own renovations. The final data was reviewed to ensure representation of the Houzz user populations.


